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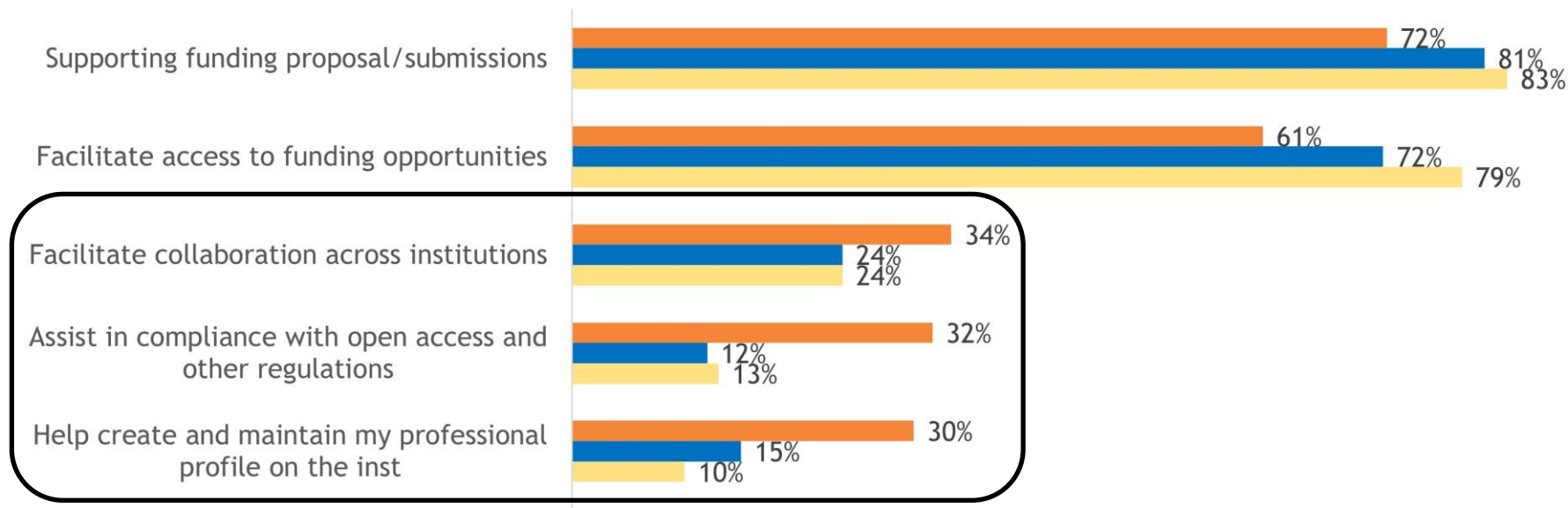

Which of the following do you expect the Research Office to do to support your role as a researcher?



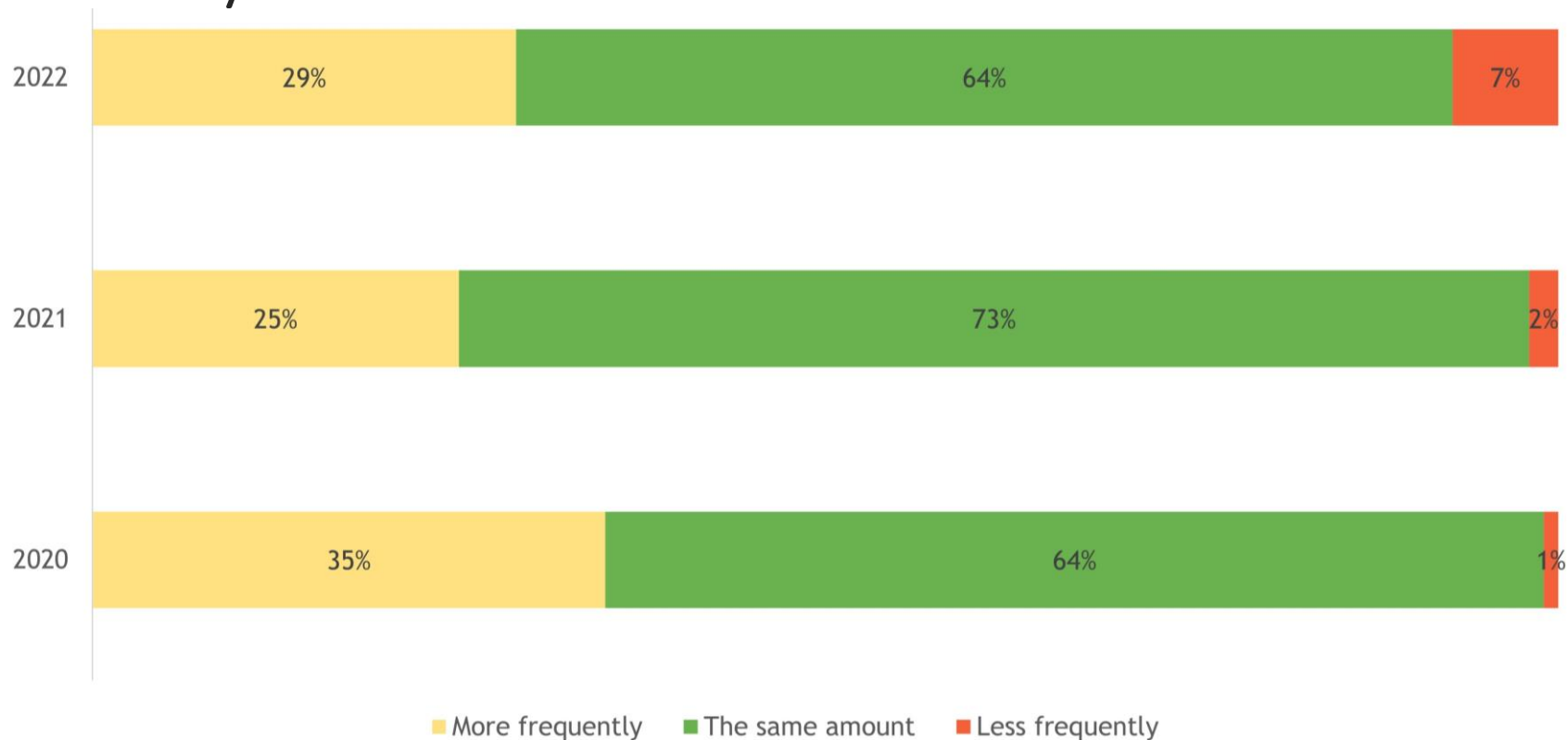

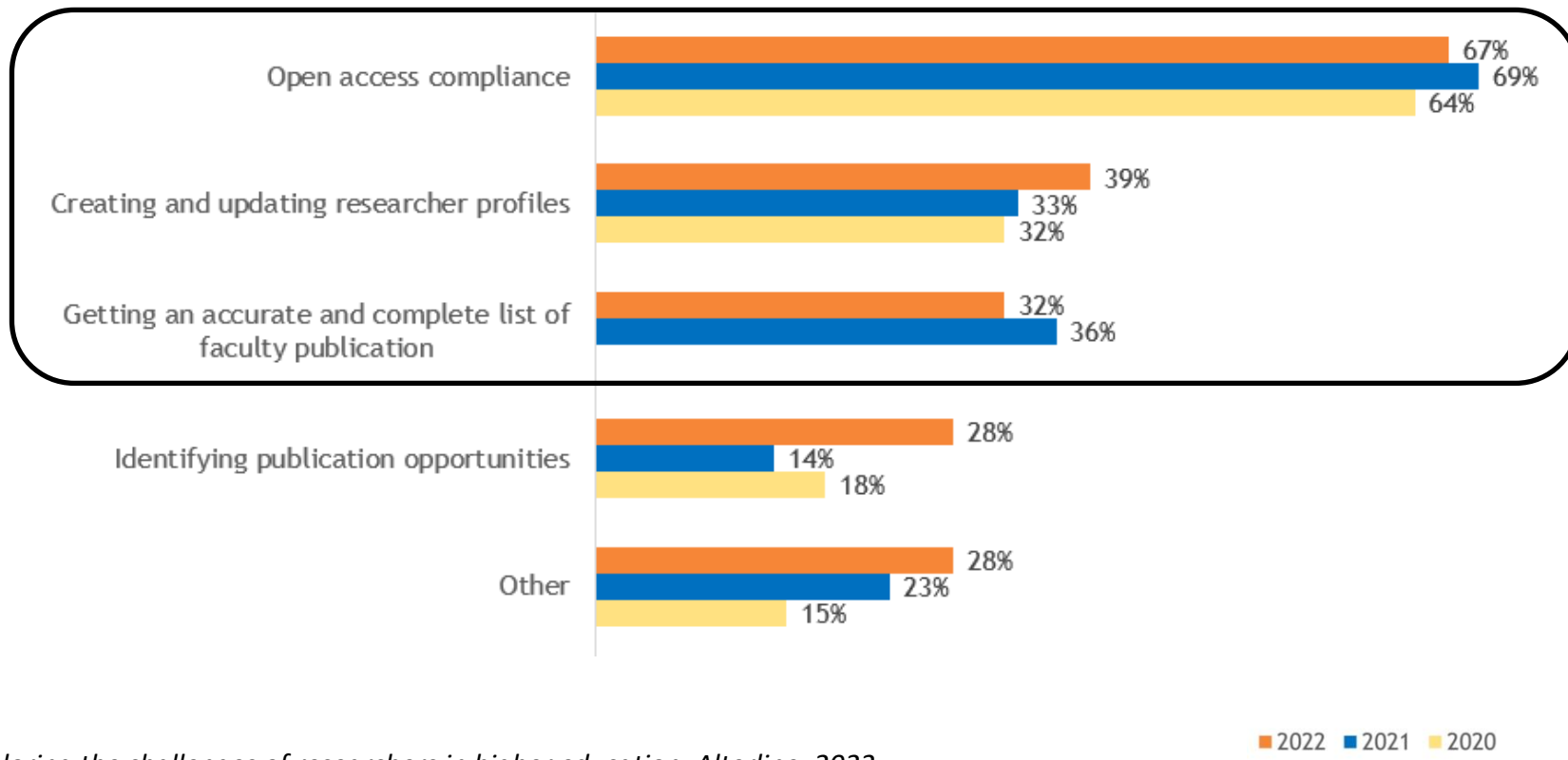

What sort of activities do you, the Research Office, collaborate with the library on?



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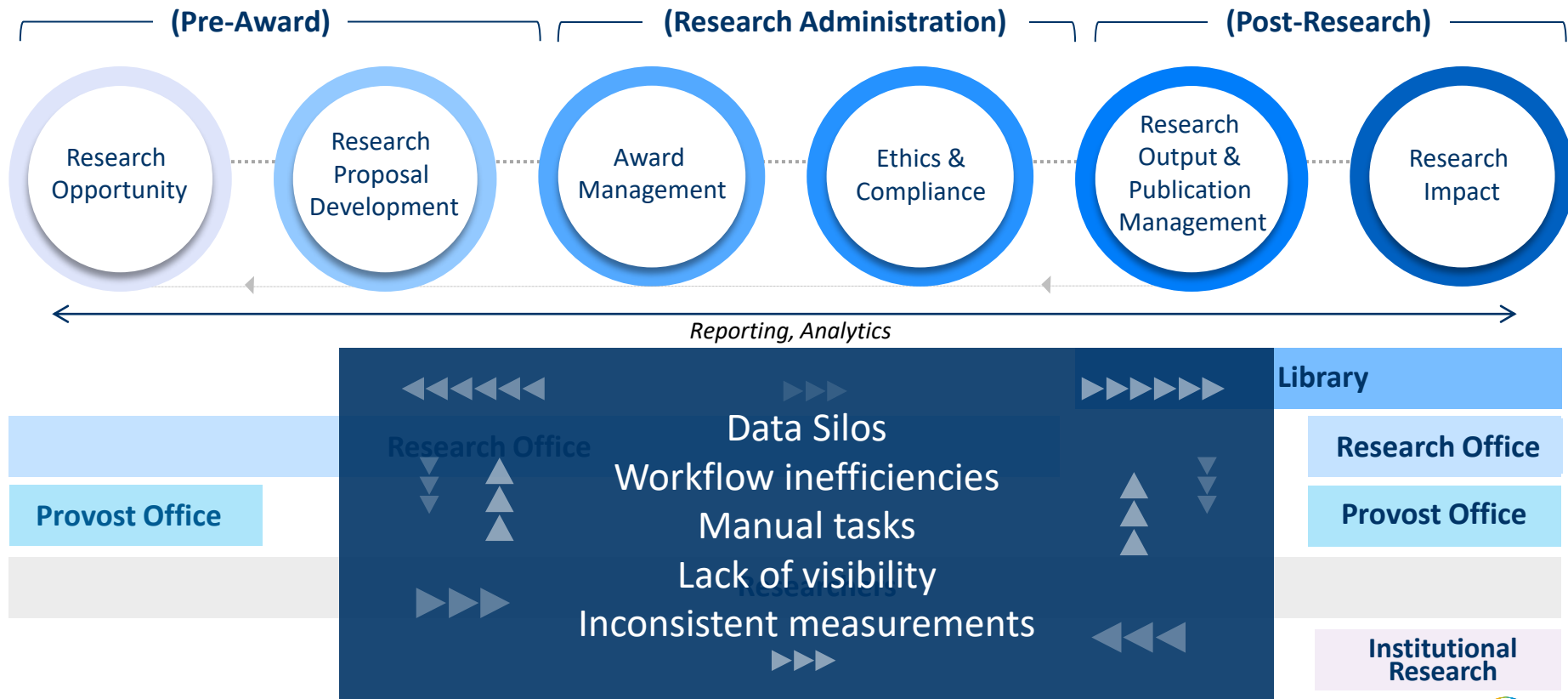

Output Discovery & Showcasing

Exploro brings institutional research work into one place. **Data is captured automatically from various virtual sources or semi-automatically. Another way to enlarge the repository is with Web of Science. The data is showcased in a research portal and profiles.**

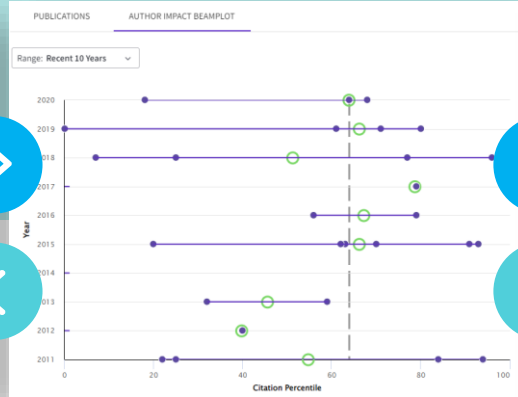

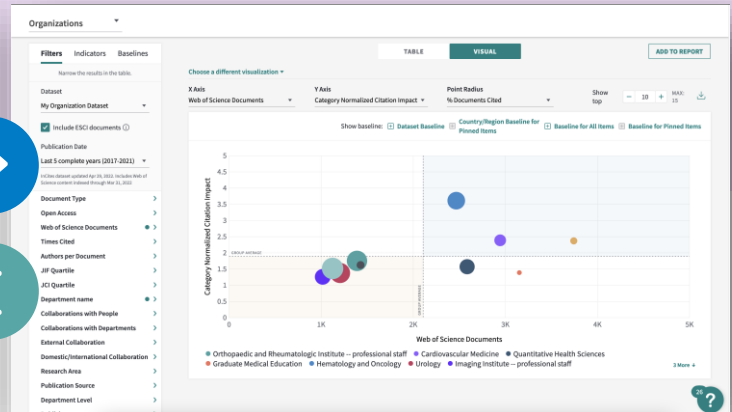
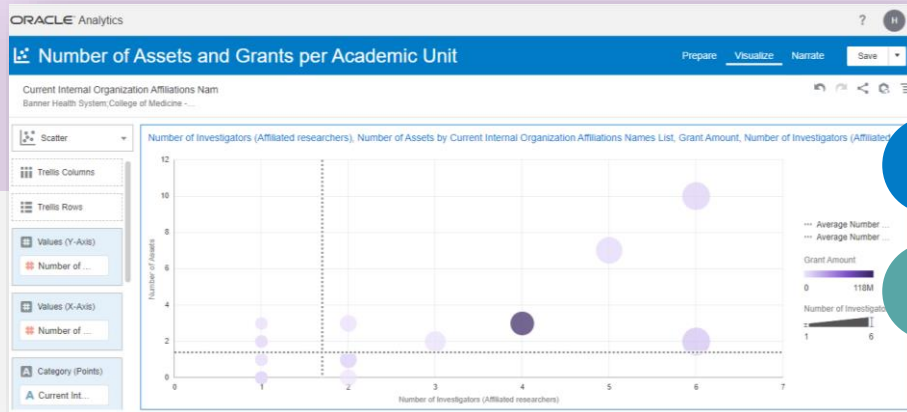
