

- Researchers US, UK, Australia; 300 responses




Which of the following do you expect the Research Office to do to support your role as a researcher?











Output Discovery & Showcasing

Esploro brings institutional research work into one place. Data is captured automatically from various virtual sources or semi-automatically. Another way to enlarge the repository is with Web of Science.

The data is showcased in a research portal and profiles.




