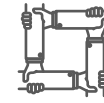

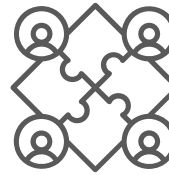

How a Network Zone Can Help

Item Retention

The Network Zone allows libraries to:

- View items' retention information across all members for NZ shared catalog records
- Manage shared collection and retention information using network Analytics, e.g.:
 - Identify titles held by single member, by metadata or network's Link ID, to add retention commitment
 - Identify titles held by multiple members, to assess collection redundancy
 - Check loans per institution, to evaluate holding's usage and efficiency

Joint Use and Storage

The shared catalog and Network Zone also lets libraries:

- Establish host locations: Purchasing in one institution while shelving at another
- Managing a shared / collective storage as a location in a single IZ
- Managing collective storage as a dedicated IZ

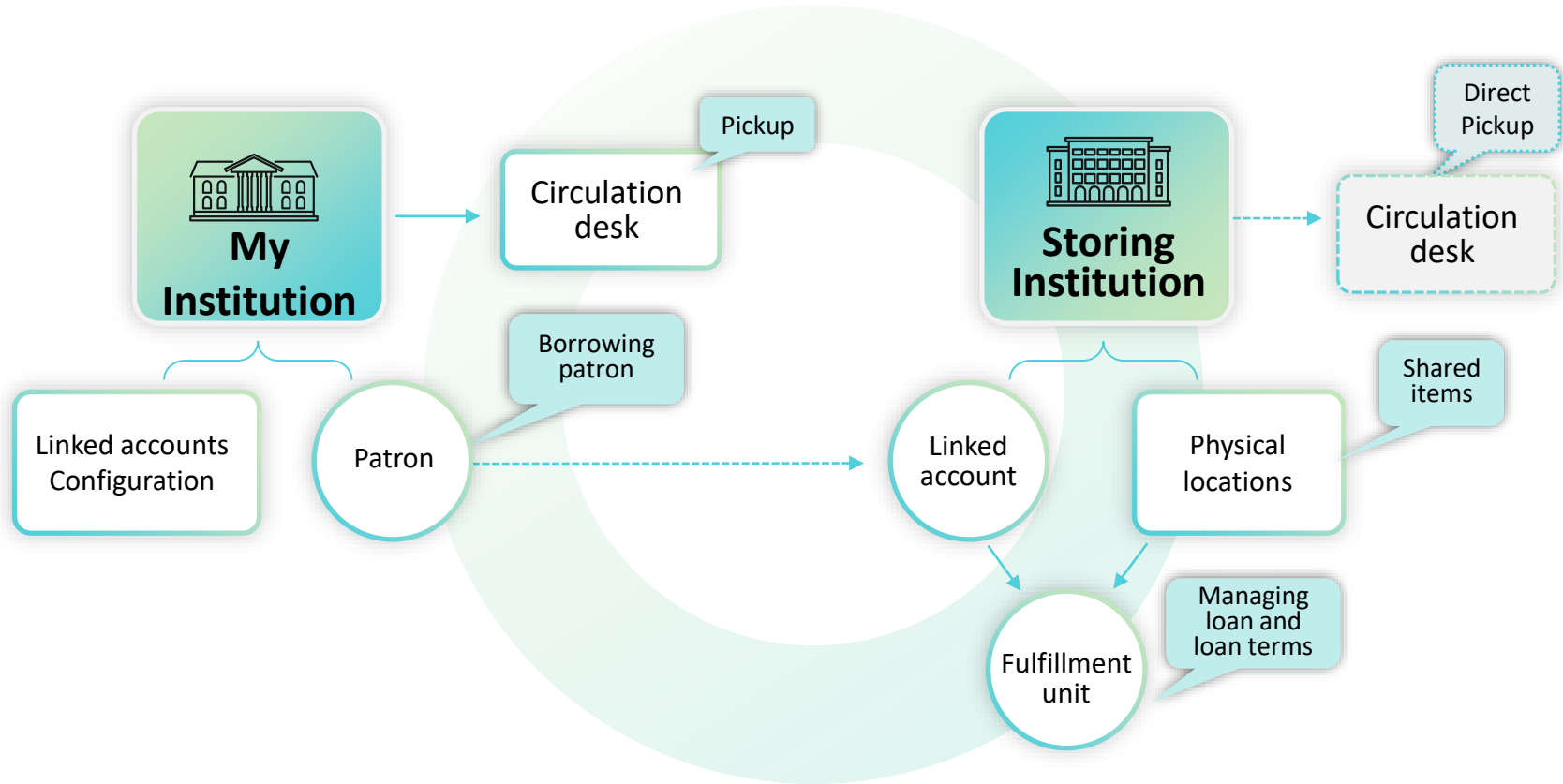

So, How do I use Alma to Strengthen Collaboration?

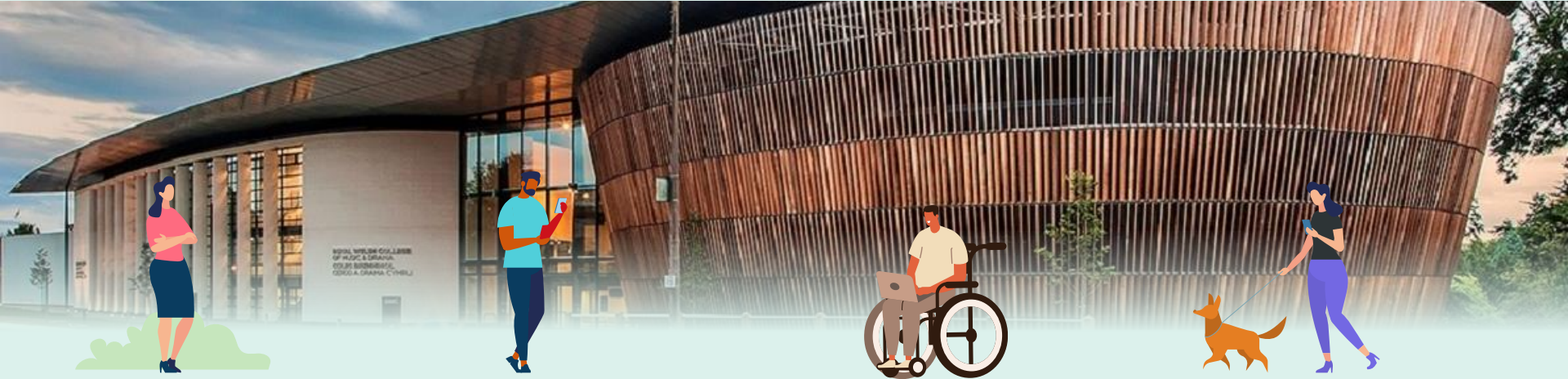
- Mark items I'm committed to retain, to avoid accidentally withdrawing them
- Communicate my commitments using publishing / APIs
- Manage my commitments and collaborative collections using Analytics
- Manage my network's commitments and collection using NZ & Analytics
- Establishing joint locations in my network
- Exposing the collaborative collection and joint locations in Primo VE
