Introduction - What is the Overlap Analysis Tool?

- This tool compares e-resources and provides reports about their overlapping status
- It assists making decisions for purchasing or canceling e-resources
- It helps the library to achieve easy and better collection-development management

Improved Overlap Analysis Tool


- New functionality introduces support for additional use cases





Budget reduction due to global recession and Covid-19

Continuous need for new purchases to stay updated with new publications of legacy and new journals



What is the Problem?

Comparison Capabilities



Manually – almost impossible



Using 3rd party comparison provides only limited capabilities



Saving the analysis reports for future review













One System

Direct access to IZ, CZ, NZ electronic resources which enables easy generation of complicated reports

Intuitive User Experience

Easy workflow for generating the desired report



Analysis Reports

Clear UI summary report and a dedicated excel report for each overlapping report type



History Reports

History analysis reports are saved in Alma for future review



The tool can perform two types of analyses:

1 | "Compare collections":

Compare one IZ / NZ / CZ e.collection with one / many e.collections from either IZ (+All) / NZ (+All) / CZ Compare with collections from:

- Selected collections from Institution Zone
- Selected collections from Network Zone
- Selected collections from Community Zone
-) Entire Institution Zone
- Entire Network Zone
 - Include only the electronic collections available for my institution in the Network Zone
 - Include only the electronic collections not available for my institution in the Network Zone
 - O Include all the electronic collections available in the Network Zone


