View how much money students have saved by using Leganto reading lists (and therefore library resources) in their courses

- 1. In Alma, open Analytics menu and select Design Analytics
- 2. In the Analytics page, select **Catalog**
- 3. Navigate to Shared Folders/Community/Reports/Shared Reports/Reports/Leganto Course Reading Lists
- 4. Find the report Student Savings from Leganto Lists and click Edit
- 5. Look at the Number of Students Impacted report.

You can review the information. If you would like to copy a report for your own use:

- 6. Click Catalog again to navigate back to the list of reports
- 7. Find the report you would like to copy and click on **Edit**
- 8. Click Save As to save the report into your institutional folder

The report uses a set dollar amount of \$75 per list. If you would like to change the dollar amount per list:

- 9. Click on the Criteria tab
- 10. Click on the gear icon on the Potential Savings column and choose Edit formula
- 11. Change 75.00 to a number of your choosing
- 12. Click **OK**
- 13. Repeat steps 10-12 for the Actual Savings column
- 14. Click the **Results** tab to view your data
