Introduction



- An Alma Analytics Object is an entity in Alma that allows for easy access to an Alma Analytics report or dashboard.
- The types of objects are:
 - Dashboard
 - Scheduled Dashboard
 - Report
 - Scheduled Report
 - Widget



Which Reports and Dashboards Can Become Objects?



Only reports and dashboards in the following folders in the analytics Catalog can become analytics Objects for sharing:

- Shared Folders / Alma created by Ex Libris staff
- Shared Folders / [your institution ID] created by staff at your institution
- Shared Folders / [Leganto] [Rapido] etc if you have that service


All subfolders within the above are also available

Common Problems to Avoid



- Dashboard objects can contain dashboards from the Alma folder (created by Ex Libris staff), but Report objects must come from your institution's folder
- Reports sent by email will use the Analytics Letter, so that needs to be configured and enabled
- Try to avoid special characters in filenames or folder names (especially the slash /)
- Helpful to organize in folders in the analytics Catalog: Dashboards, Reports, Widgets

- 1. Analytics Menu > Analytics Object List
- 2. Actions > Add New Alma Analytics Object
- 3. Analytic Folder: [your institution folder]
- 4. Report Name: [pick a report]
- 5. Save
- 6. Wait for it ...!

- 7. In analytics object editor, add **Roles** as desired
 - Be sure to include Analytics Administrator
- 8. Select Add to Favorites
- Find report on Analytics menu
