Introduction



- This presentation will describe the new Author Info Card based on Linked Data, tentatively planned for August 2023.
- Currently the Info Card uses information based on linked data from Wikidata for Authors and Contributors
- Future plans include additional bibliographic fields and additional linked data vocabularies



Introduction



- The highlights of this feature are:
- Enrich the discovery experience in the Primo VE Full Display with a new Information Card about the Authors and Contributors, powered by Wikidata.
- If available, utilize Linked Data URIs such as Creator and Contributor Wikidata links to present additional information on linked entities.
- Enhance the Linked Data Info Card to present information from additional sources.

- To enable this feature there is one setting required:
- Set the parameter "enable_person_info_card" to "true" in the table "Discovery Customer Settings".
- This table is accessed at "Configuration > Discovery > Other > Customer Settings".










