Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery

- It is possible to configure the system so that the metadata fields that appear in Alma viewers will be the same fields that appear in Primo VE Details display section.
- In this manner, the institution can display the same descriptive information in Alma viewers as are displayed in Primo VE.

Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery

- To enable this feature, select the “Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery” check box.
- This is found at “Configuration > Fulfillment > Discovery Interface Display Logic > Other Settings”

Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery

Other Settings

- Enable Display of License Information
- Enable Display of Access Model
- Include Representation services in link resolver statistics
- Enable Delivery Login
- Max. Number of Representations in View
- Order of ViewIt Services
- Group Representation Delivery Services by
- Delimiter for Grouping Repeated Delivery Metadata
- Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery
- Display Collection Path In Viewer
- Find GetIt services based on standard identifiers only
- Generate thumbnails from inactive representations

Note that when “Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery” is checked the “Delimiter for Grouping Repeated Delivery Metadata” is greyed out (because it is irrelevant)

Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery

- Note that when “Use Primo Metadata Fields for Delivery” is checked the “Hide Repeated Labels” is removed from the Alma Viewer Service Details options.

Hide Repeated Labels and delimiters for repeated metadata

- The fields in the description of the Alma Viewer are the same fields that appear in the “Details” section of Primo display
