Click on positive - Select new color #3c067f6. Click Update Theme <p>Documentation: Changing View Colors</p>

7.	Library Logo:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click Choose Logo File<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your logo image needs to be a PNG or a SVG file, and the filename will need to end in underscore logo. (for example, MyLib_logo.png).• The maximum size is 300 pixels wide by 100 pixels tall.• The size of the image cannot exceed 30KB.2. Click Upload Images
8.	Library Favicon:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click Choose favicon<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The favicon files must be of type ICO <filename>.ico (for example, favicon.ico)2. Click Upload Images <p>Note: Favicon icon is not visible in Primo Studio and will need to be uploaded into live Primo</p>

9.	Library Icons Svg:	<p>Ensure that the SVG ID matches the ID used in Primo.</p> <p>Go to Using the Icons Tab documentation for more detail</p>
10.	Resource icons:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click Choose resource type icon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The resource type icon files must be of type PNG and use the following naming convention: icon_<resource_type>.png (for example, icon_book.png). <p>There is an upload limit of 1MB. If you exceed the limit, use multiple uploads to load all images.</p>

19.	Email	<p>Go to the editor window</p> <p>Go to <Header></p> <p>Change the bgcolor="#4d6b82" to bgcolor="#4bfbe7"</p> <p>Click Apply Temporary changes</p>
20.	Download	<p>Click Download button</p> <p>Save the package file to your desktop</p>
21.	Upload Primo Studio Customizations to live Primo VE	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to the folder of on your computer where the package file in the previous step was saved 2. Extract the file. 3. Open the extracted package folder 4. See a folder with your View Code 5. Compress that folder: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For Windows users, we recommend using a compression tool such as 7zip or Winrar instead of Windows Send to > Compress folder to avoid upload errors. • For Mac users, use the following procedure to zip and remove any hidden .DS_Store files: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Open the Terminal application under Applications > Utilities. b. Move to the parent directory of the folder that you want to compress. For example: <pre>cd /Users/<user name>/<parent folder></pre> c. Enter the following command to compress the file: <pre>zip -r <target file>.zip <My_View> -x "*.DS_Store"</pre>

23.	Upload Package tab	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose the zipped Customization package file with your view name 2. Click Upload Package
24.	Go to Themes tab	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Change the background color to #ffffff 2. Click Update Theme
25.	Remove Addon	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to Addon tab 2. Find primo-explore-search-bar-sub-menu Hook: prm-search-bar-after 3. Click Remove
26.	Download the package	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to Download tab 2. Click Download
27.	Upload changes to Primo	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Extract the folder downloaded in previous step 2. See a folder with your View Code 3. Compress that folder (using 7-zip recommended) 4. Go to Alma > Discovery > Display Configuration > Configure Views > Edit your View > Manage Customization Package tab 5. Under the Upload Package section choose your compressed Customization Package folder 6. Click Upload 7. When upload completes click SAVE
