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





Central Discovery Index (CDI)



- Unified index that supports Summon, Primo and Primo VE.
- Search profile slots that have been configured to use the CentralIndex search profile search CDI content and includes that content in search results.








What's in the CDI

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- Over 5 billion <u>citations</u>
- Commercial and Open Access content from global and local providers
- Most resources are free to search—some require a subscription
- Content includes 29 <u>CDI resource types</u> that were determined in collaboration with the IGELU and ELUNA user groups.







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Alma/CZ/CDI Workflow



2. Order/Activation Workflow in Alma

4. Central Discovery Index harvests the file



1. Locate electronic resource in the Community Zone

3. Alma creates CDI holdings file

5. Electronic holdings display in Discovery in 48-72 hours
