85% of students say paying for course materials is financially stressful



More then half

of students don't buy some of their course materials



43% of students have skipped meals to pay for course materials



3/10 students have decided not to take a course because of materials cost




Faculty want to use affordable course materials



"The majority of faculty want to ease the cost burden of course materials for their students, preferring to assign texts that are available at low or no cost (88 percent) or through the library (61 percent)." In the first three academic years in which the university used Leganto resource lists, the potential **savings for the student body surpassed \$4M**




As with many things in life, affordability is important. We want to be able to **contain costs for our students** and Leganto allows us to do that.

"Libraries Course Materials Page" cost savings calculation

[Enrollment] x [\$75] = [Cost Savings]

This formula is based on the recommended average cost¹ of a textbook devised by the Open Education Network. While the OEN uses \$100 as the average cost of a textbook, the University of Minnesota Libraries has decided to use a cost savings of \$75 based on an OpenStax recommendation² and examples from other schools such as Oregon State University³.

"LCMP royalty payments required" cost savings calculation

[Enrollment] x [\$35] = [Cost Savings]

When a section's reading list contains a copyright/royalty payment, the University of Minnesota Libraries has decided to use a cost savings of \$35. This is based on our own analysis of the average cost of copyrighted materials, the example of Oregon State¹, and common practice in the field when considering "low cost" courses².






Course Materials Savings Dashboard - University of Minnesota Libraries

Future development/plans


- Potential exists to dig deeper into the data and examine areas for improved outreach (underrepresented communities, outreach to faculty in underserved departments and colleges).
- "Affordable courses" visualization
 - Use this same data to design a student searchable tool they can use to identify courses and instructors that use affordable course materials.
 - Add this to course catalog for students to use when selecting courses
- Include data from the U of M Bookstores
 - The bookstores have low cost data that could be added
- Using the dashboard to increase usage of Course Materials Services
 - Encourage university instructors to "join the revolution"
