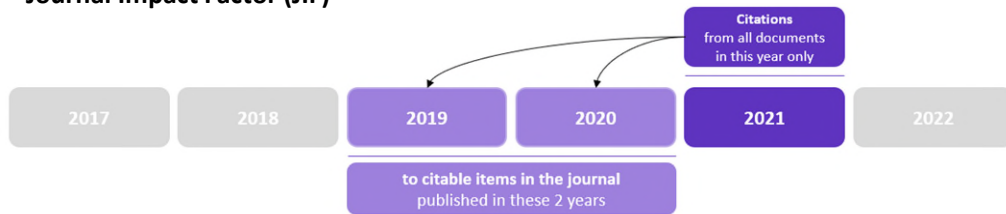

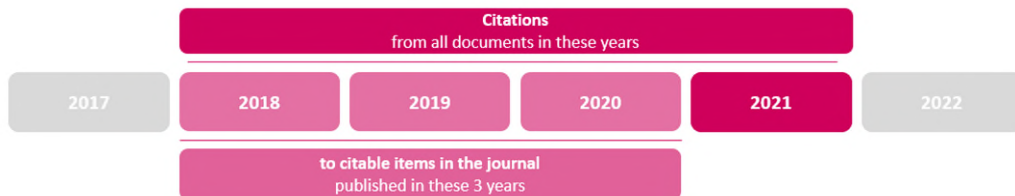

# Get enhanced collection development reporting

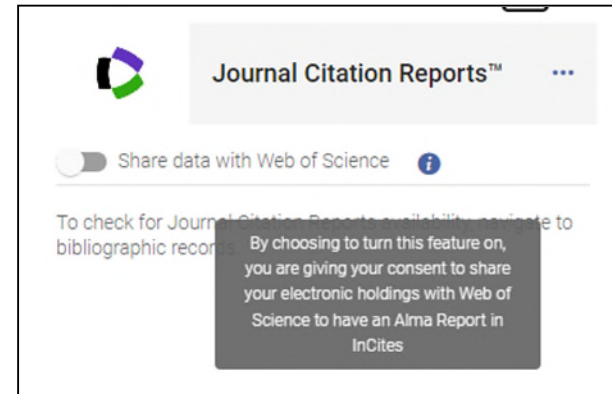
In May, mutual customers can opt in via Alma to share their holdings information with InCites and gain access to new, custom, pre-configured collection development reports in InCites.

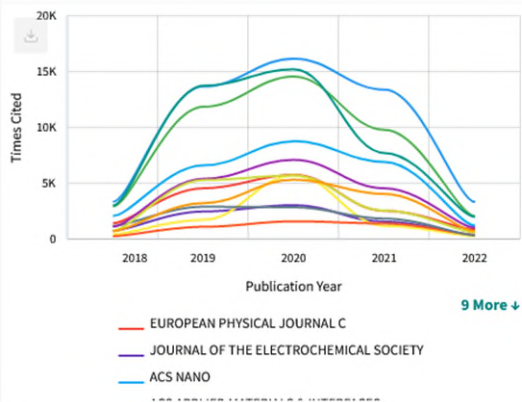

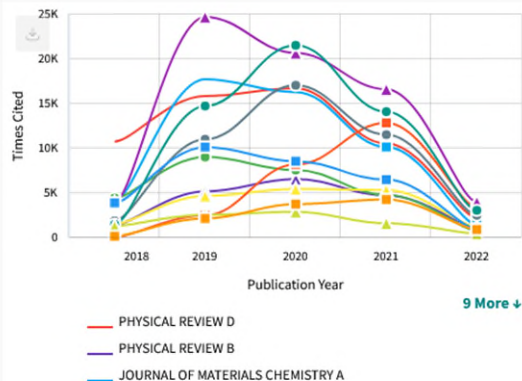

# What can InCites reports reveal?

## New subscription recommendations

Identify journals outside of your current collection that have high publication or citation activity associated with your researchers and investigate whether they should be part of your collection.

## Specialized needs by department

Filter reports by 250+ research areas to assess local needs as well as find areas of high cross-disciplinary activity.

## Validation of title requests

Supplement ILL request data with cited reference counts, which in some cases outnumber loan requests and can serve as a “more reliable indicator of campus demand.”\*
