





Impact Metrics are powered by data from the Web of Science Core Collection


Top-level metrics that display on profiles include:






Adding your Web of Science Researcher ID


Users can add a Web of Science Research ID by going to their Profile and selecting "Edit Profile"

Additional Metrics Available in Web of Science




Authenticated users in Web of Science can see a **metrics dashboard** and a full citation report

Unique metrics include the Author Impact Beamplot Summary which measures the performance of an article against a similar set of papers

Web of Science profiles also include citing and cited by patent information to assess contributions around innovation










View Publication and Citation Activity over Time

Geographic Citation Map The citation map shows the distribution of

The citation map shows the distribution of the researcher's citations across the globe:

- For each article in the Web of Science Core Collection that cited the researcher's work, a city with a contributing author's institution represents a data point
- A publication may appear under multiple locations if the contributing authors are affiliated with different institutions
- The number of data points on the map may be higher than the sum of times cited in the Web of Science Core Collection


Blue circles can be clicked to zoom in and see more precise locations, red pins can be clicked to see the details of papers citing the researcher's work from a particular city.

The citation map may take a while to load if there are more than 1,000 citations.






Non-authenticated users still see valuable metrics


Some features on Web of Science profiles require a user to be authenticated to view them. However, non-authenticated users can still see an author's 10 most recent publications and other Core citation metrics

New – Advanced Search Funder Search Options



Running advanced searches by funder are now easier with two distinct ways to search:


Use **Free Text Search** if you want to search partial funder names in the funder field

or

Use **Browse/Autocomplete** to select specific funders from a type-ahead view of Pivot-RP funders



Browse/Autocomplete to Select Funders




Easily find funders to include in searches from across the complete list of more than 15,000 funders tracked by Pivot-RP

relevant.


Recipients can see if an opportunity deadline has been **Extended, Postponed** or is **Coming soon**.

Add Expiration Dates to Notes




Admins can now add expiration dates to notes

Related Programmes






