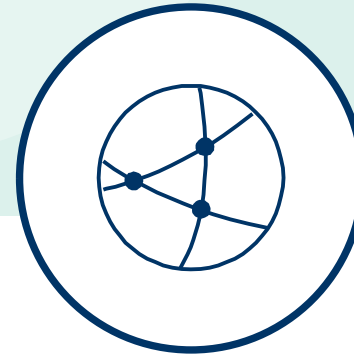




Title Alerts and Faculty Alerts

Streamline new title acquisitions and collaborate on purchasing decisions



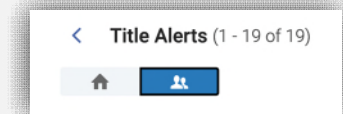
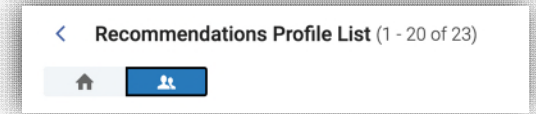


Enhanced Deposit Accounts

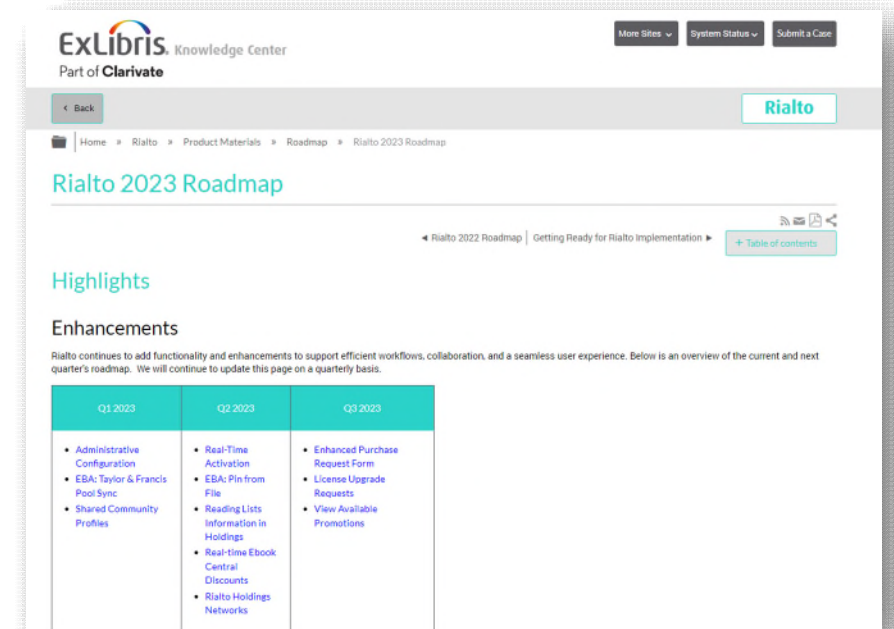

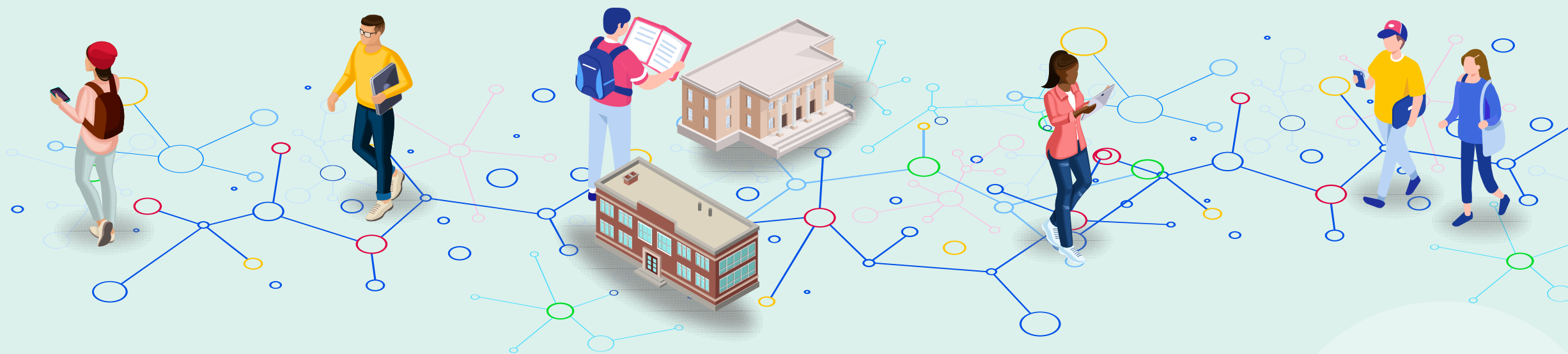
