Open Source ≠ Open Platform



Open source software is:

- software with source code that anyone can inspect, modify, and enhance



In computing, an Open Platform:

- describes a software system which is based on open standards, such as published and fully documented external application programming interfaces (API) that allow using the software to function in other ways than the original programmer intended, without requiring modification of the source code

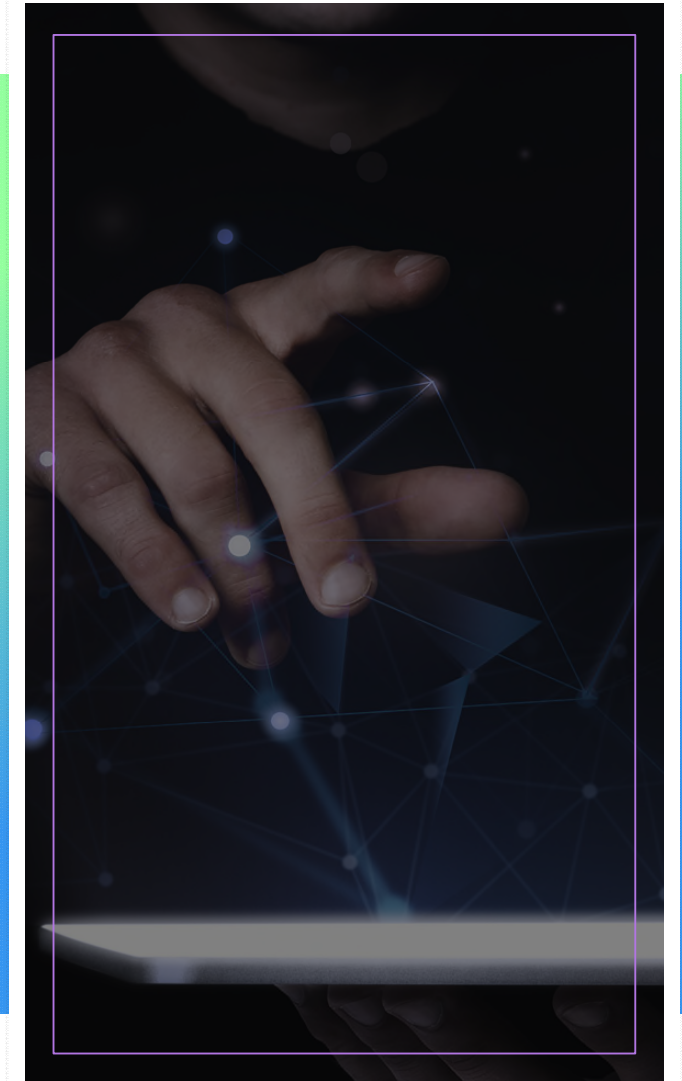

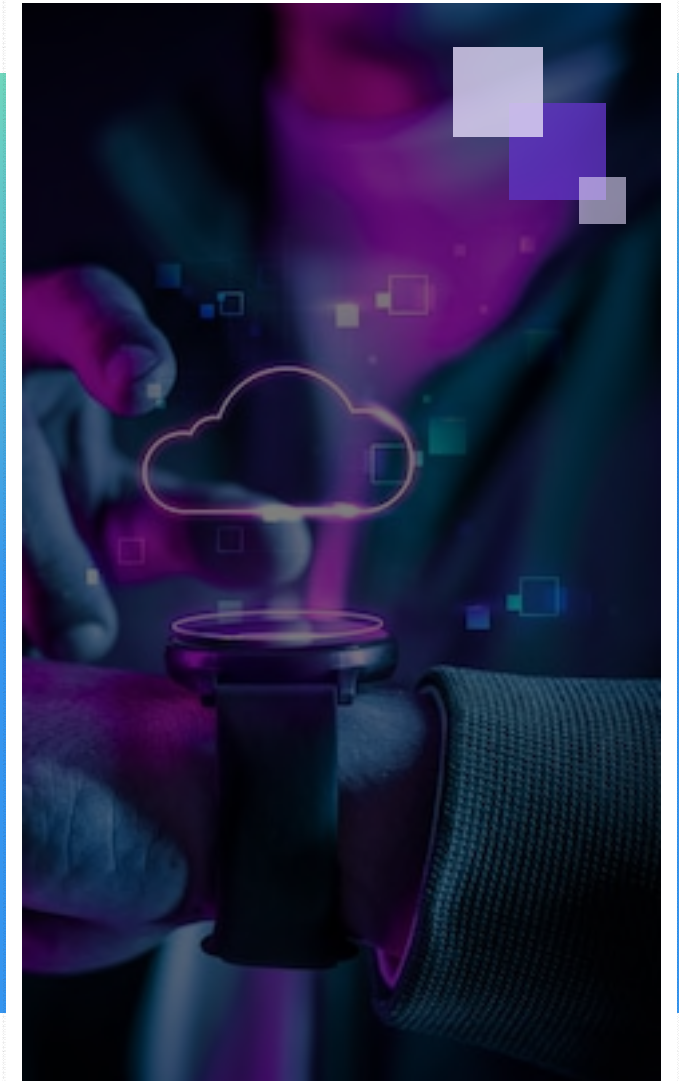
