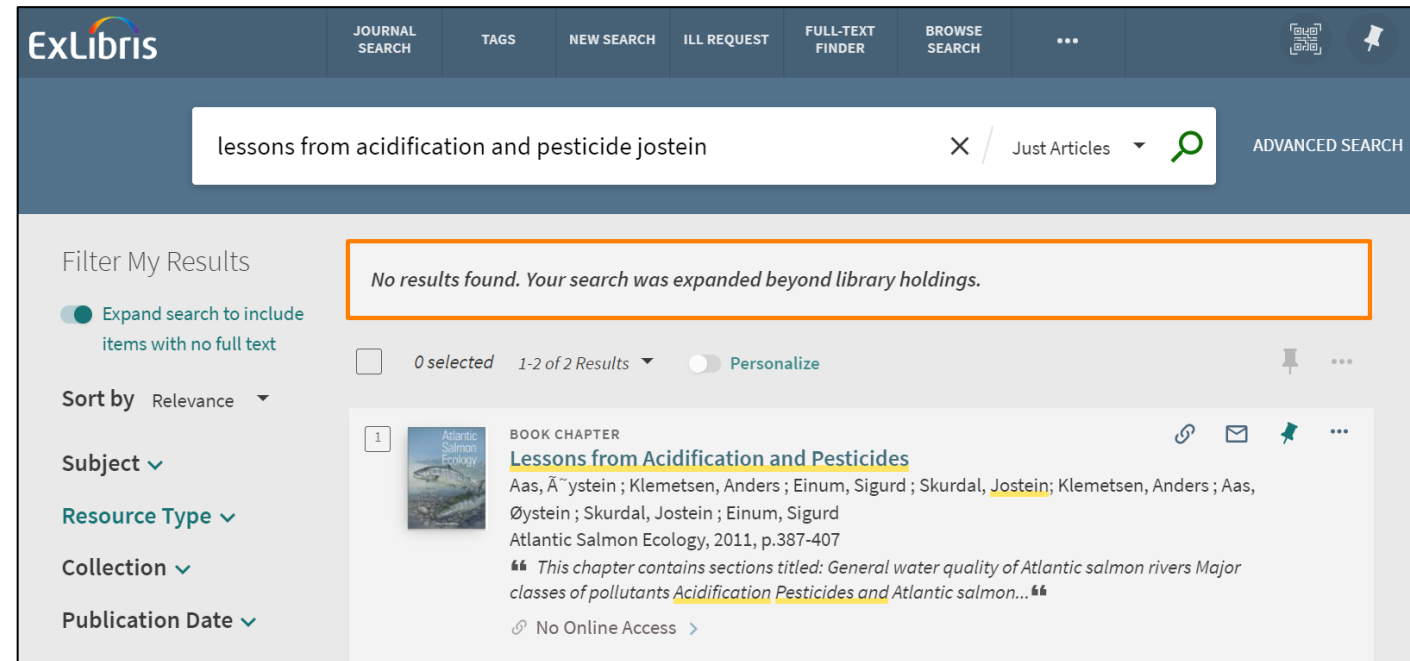
Improve Search Experience for No Results Found

If no results are found when searching the CDI scope or Blended scope, the search may be expanded automatically to include results beyond your library's activations. A message appears notifying users of the auto-expanded mode with an option to turn it off.

Previously the “**Copy Citation to Clipboard**” option used in the Citation Action didn’t preserve the original formatting while pasting the citation.

Now you can paste the citation text and choose to keep its original formatting

Support Restricted Availability Statuses for External Records




So far , records loaded from external data sources were considered unrestricted and given the **Available online**, Now you can display a different availability status for external records with restricted or no access to full text based on a defined conditions

Configuration

Add a new section for "Link to Resource - Other Statuses" with a new checkbox "Create link" indicates if to build a link under the view it and under the links section

Additional Notable Items

Resource Recommender - Enhanced Search Capability

Previously, Resource Recommender returned suggested resources by performing an exact match to a searchable tag. This enhancement allows suggested resources to be returned through the enrichment of searchable tags by adding synonyms and inflections, removing stop words from tags and searches, accepting non-ordered search words.

→ This feature was delayed from August due to issues found -> it is now available with the November release

Option to track Quicklinks usage per providers using the subject area Primo Customized Values Usage for the actions:

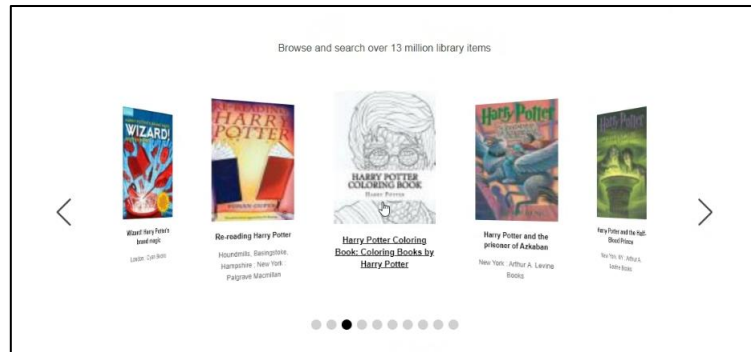

Primo Showcase - Discovery Showcase Allowed Domains

Primo showcase displays a visual carousel of items tailored to the library's specifications, helping libraries promote their unique or new content and encouraging exploration and traffic to the library discovery system from sites such as University and faculty pages



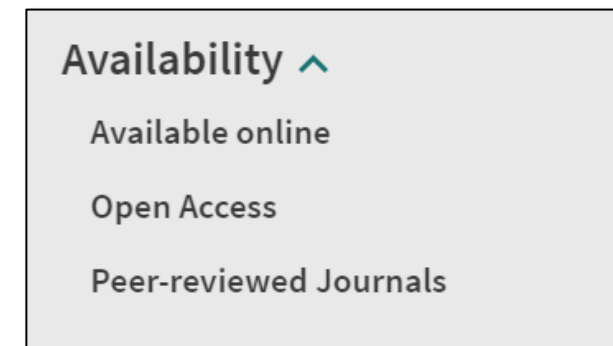
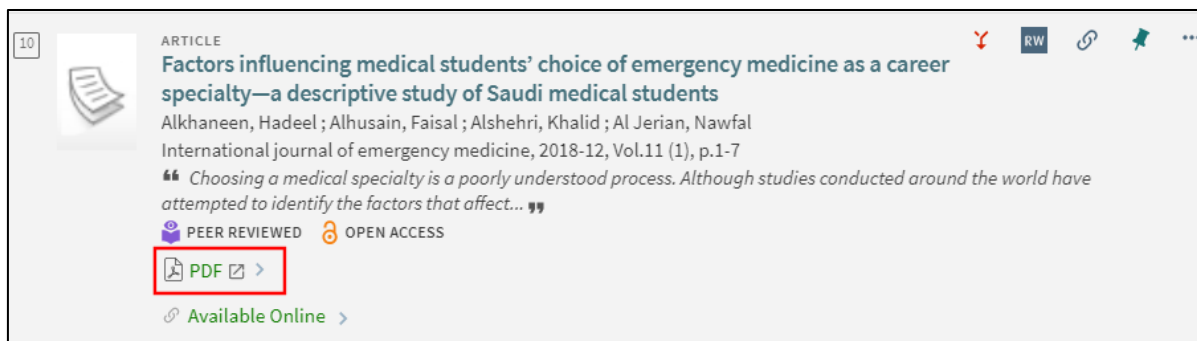
- Will be available in Q1 2024 for Primo VE customers

Support Filtering of CDI Records with OA Links from Unpaywall

All CDI Records with OA links from Unpaywall will be flagged as 'Full text Available', allow users to filter their searches by Availability and Open Access

Unpaywall is a database of Open Access Content that maintains Open Access (OA) links to full text articles and Open Access resources. **This database is now included in the CDI index** and included as a collection in the Alma Community Zone and SFX KnowledgeBase.

Activating the Unpaywall collection is now the recommended method for including Unpaywall OA links in Primo and Primo VE.



Subject Heading Normalization Project



Three Fields

- **Subject:** populated from controlled vocabulary, deduplicated and normalized
- **Keyword:** all subjects/keywords that cannot be mapped to the subject field
- **LATER Discipline:** all discipline level subjects, according to a controlled list



Iteration 1

- Subject and keyword field
- LCSH, MeSH, and some additions from PQ thesauri
- Optional: **February** (Primo)
- Test option (for the facets) available for Primo customers **&searchCDI=normalizedSubjects**
