# CDI, Alma, and Discovery

## Discovery

- **Central Discovery Index**
- **Includes over 5 billion citations**
- **Accessible in both of Ex Libris' discovery systems**
- **Most resources are free to search**
- **Some A&I databases require a subscription to search**

## Delivery

- **Linking to content via Alma**
- **Full-text content in its own database/repository**
- **Direct linking or use of link resolver**
- **May require authentication or authorization to access**



  - Publishing includes the collection’s ID (DBID)
  - CDI matches content based on the ID and marks all database content in CDI as ‘Available Online’



## Option 1: Activate/Deactivate Collection in Alma

If you set the **Service Activation status** to “Not Available”:

- Shows as “No Access” in search results
- Links to full text will not appear in full record


## Option 2: 'Do not show as Full Text available...'

If collection is **Active** in Alma, you can select **"Do not show as Full Text available in CDI even if active in Alma"**:

- Shows as 'unavailable' in search results
- Links to full text will still appear in full record


**Use Case:** Prevent OA content from cluttering search results



## Option 3: CDI Search Scope

You can specialize the CDI search scope and limit the scope results.

- **Filter by Availability** –display only CDI records that have full text



## Option 4: 'Activate for Full Text in CDI only'

If collection is **inactive** in Alma, you can mark it as 'Available Online' only in CDI  
With the "Activate for Full Text in CDI only" settings.

- Shows as 'Available' in search results
- Direct link to full text will appear in full record
- For collections that use the **link in record** rather than the link resolver

- If collection that is a selective package is Active in Alma, you have the option to mark the entire collection content as 'Available Online' in CDI regardless of the portfolio's activation in Alma
- For collections that use the **link in record** rather than the link resolver
