



What This Tool Can Do

Automatically manage (activate and deactivate) all the e-resources you access via the ProQuest Ebook Central (EBC) Platform



- Owned titles (perpetual access)
- Subscription titles (live or trial)
- PDA/DDA (Patron- and Demand-Driven Acquisition)

Post-Configuration Workflow



You don't have to do this yourself!

Ask Ex Libris' Alma Support Team to set these configurations.

- Save time!
- Ensure the configuration is correct!



Configuration Steps

1. Contact ProQuest Support

- Ask them to enable automatic updates
- Get EBC Site ID

2. Contact Alma Support

- Ask them to set up required parameters

3. Activate the EBC Perpetual, DDA ... collection

- Deactivate other (manually updated) EBC collections

4. Create EBC Integration Profile

5. Set up order-recording process (if desired)

Activate the Collection

Ebook Central Perpetual, DDA and Subscription Titles

- Activate Collection and Service
- Don't activate individual portfolios
- If it's already activated (with some portfolios):
 - This tool will keep things going
 - Local portfolio information will be preserved



De-Activate All Other Ebook Central Subscriptions

This system automatically handles **all** ProQuest Ebook Central subscriptions.

Deactivate the rest to avoid duplicate portfolios:

- Ebook Central Academic ...
- Ebook Central Science ...
- Ebook Central University of ...

All collections that start "Ebook Central ..."

Configure Order-Recording System

(after placing order with ProQuest)

Three options for recording the order in Alma:

- PO line created via Real Time Order
- PO line created via EOD using “New Order” import profile
- PO line created manually



PO Line Created via Real Time Order

1. "New Order" API is sent from PQ to Alma.
2. Alma searches IZ for that portfolio by Ebook Central title ID or ISBN.
3. If match found in IZ, PO line is associated with that portfolio.
4. If no match found, Alma searches CZ for that portfolio in "Ebook Central Perpetual .."
 - Portfolio is activated in IZ and associated with the PO line.



PO Line Created via EOD File and Import Profile

1. Configure a New Order import profile
 - Copy "PQ Ebook Central import profile"
 - Configure profile to correctly match (**demo**)
2. Run import profile on EOD file.
3. Alma searches IZ (and, if needed, CZ) for matching portfolio (just like previous page) and associates portfolio with new PO line.



PO Line Created Manually - Use Case 1

If portfolio already was activated by this “Automatic Upload of Electronic Holdings” process, then:

1. Find portfolio in IZ in collection “Ebook Central Perpetual ...”
2. Click Order on the portfolio
 - Fill out details as needed for previous order
3. Next time, this will update automatically



PO Line Created Manually - Use Case 2

If portfolio was purchased outside Alma (LibCentral for example) and is not yet activated:

1. Find portfolio in CZ in the collection "Ebook Central Perpetual ..."
2. Click Order on the portfolio
 - Fill out details as needed for the order
3. Portfolio is activated and associated with PO
4. Next time, this will update automatically



Preserve Previous Ebook Central Acquisition Details

(Because you acquired Ebook Central portfolios in other collections, which are now deactivated.)

1. Create a Set (content type = electronic collections) that includes the other Ebook Central collections
2. Run the Job "Move electronic portfolio information" **demo**



Institutions with Rialto

1. Rialto allows selection and purchasing right within Alma
2. Automated Holdings Management works great with Rialto
3. Request assistance from Rialto Support

When You Test This in Your Sandbox

Enable FTP connection for the ProQuest feed files:

1. Alma Configuration
2. General menu > External Systems > Allowed S/FTP connections
3. Add FTP:
ftp.ebrary.com / ftp.ebrary.com
4. Save

(Not needed in your Production environment; these are already enabled.)




