

Background – Current CDI Collection Types

- Full text collection with portfolios, using Link Resolver
- Full text collection with portfolios, using the Link in Record
- Database with Full text using Link in Record
- A&I database using Link Resolver





NEW: Hybrid Full Text Collections


 Some collections contain a mix of content types: traditional academic content such as journals and books, but also non-traditional content types such as videos, images, etc.

 In Hybrid Full Text Collections, we use multiple linking methods in the same collection




What Mixed Collections Can Look Like

SFX/Alma Collection




Why We Need Hybrid Linking

- CDI Rights use
 - ☐ Title level match by identifier
 - ☐ Collection level all records of the collection
- "We subscribe to only some titles in this collection"
 - ☐ Yes title level
 - □ No collection level
- When the whole collection is Link Resolver
 - ☐ Title level records without identifiers will not appear as "available"
 - ☐ Collection level records without identifiers may have linking issues



"We subscribe to only some titles in this collection"





How to Work with Hybrid Full Text Collections

- ☐ Records with identifiers will work with the Link Resolver
- Records without identifiers (or of type dissertation) will work with Link in Record


Recommendation:

- We subscribe to only some titles in this collection = No
- All the collection's content will appear as "Fulltext available"




Example of Mixed Collections

Using Alma Level URL (Override)

• Customers who have the Alma Level URL (Override) configured (as instructed in the Configuring a Custom URL for Electronic Collections guide) Will be able to use it for the institution authentication for Link in Record content, in collections with portfolios


For example: institution who added the URL
 (http://search.proquest.com?accountid=XXXXXXX), will have direct links to ProQuest with the configured account ID which they need for authentication to PQ



DBIDs of Hybrid Collections

- Hybrid Collections have 2 DBIDs:
 - In the Provider package code (DB ID) field
 - In the CDI Collection ID (DB ID) field under CDI tab

- The main DBID is the first one
- The second is internal and used for calculating the hybrid linking.





Our Plans for Hybrid Full Text Collections

- ProQuest Central is already using hybrid linking method
- 101 ProQuest collections will be hybrid by end of September
 The list is published in the Hybrid collections CKC article
- Criteria used for PQ collection:
 Link in record when No Identifiers OR type Dissertation
- The "Hybrid" Indication on the SFX/Alma Collection will be added in October In Hybrid Full text collection, it will be:

Full text Rights: Link Resolver

Linking: Hybrid

CDI Type: Full text collection



Hybrid A&I Collections

 Some Abstracting and Indexing databases (A&I) contain full text for part of their content

 In Hybrid A&I Collections, we will use Link in Record when the A&I provider offers access to full text on their platform


- A&I content with no full text on the A&I provider's platform:
 - Will appear as "Full Text Available" only if they match to other FT activations and will use Link Resolver to link to the FT platform
 - For example Web of Science record will have link to ProQuest



Example of Hybrid A&I Collections Work

Rights: Will show as FT available if there is an identifier match to other FT activations

Linking: Link Resolver to the FT platform



Rights: Will always show as FT available

Linking: Link in Record – to the A&I Provider Platform



How to Work with Hybrid A&I Collections

Hybrid A&I collections are collections of type Database

- The new behavior will be applied when:
 - A&I collection is Hybrid check the list
 - A&I collection is active for full text in Alma
 OR uses the "activate for Full Text in CDI only" setting



Our Plans for Hybrid A&I Collections

- ERIC and ArtikelSök are already Hybrid A&I collections
- More A&I collections will be added over time
- The "Hybrid" indication on the collection will be added in October In Hybrid A&I Collection, it will be:

Full text Rights: Hybrid

Linking: Hybrid

CDI Type: Hybrid
