Increase bank account field character limit to 50

Purpose of the Enhancement

The purpose of this enhancement is to provide a larger field in which to store bank account values.

Description

The Acquisitions client now permits entry of up to 50 characters for the “Bank Account” field on the “Bank Informaton” tab when editing a Vendor.

Purpose of the Enhancement

The purpose of this enhancement is to provide a deeper look into funds still available, especially as fiscal year deadlines approach.

Description

The Acquisitions client now includes an 'Additional Balances' tab on the Fund display. This tab includes two new balances:

1. Remaining for Use if Pending Expenditures Paid, computed as Original Allocation + Allocation Increase - Allocation Decreases - Commitments - Expenditures - Pending Expenditures
2. Remaining to Obligate if Pending Commitments Approved, computed as Original Allocation + Allocation Increases - Allocation Decreases - Commitments - Expenditures - Pending Expenditures - Pending Commitments+

Allow capture/copy of BIBID, AUTHID, and MFHDID in Cataloging module

Purpose of the Enhancement

The purpose of this enhancement is to provide the ability to copy the record id of a displayed bibliographic, authority, or holdings record to use elsewhere.

Description

A new “Copy Record ID” menu option has been added to the “Edit” menu for the bibliographic, authority and holdings record display windows. Using the Shift + F3 keys performs the same copy as the menu option.

Headings Thesauri Updates

Purpose of the Enhancement

The HEADING_TYPE table has been updated with the latest additions and changes to thesaurus names.

Description

Additional headings thesauri have been added to the HEADING_TYPE table based on approved changes published between September 27, 2022 and December 05, 2023.

Implementation Notes

The new headings types are suppressed by default. Libraries who want to use a particular thesaurus or thesauri will need to unsuppress it via System Administration.

Restore local file name in logs

Purpose of the Enhancement

The purpose of this enhancement is to allow better matching of the original input file name to the file name displayed in the log.

Description

The file name is sanitized by replacing all non-alphabetic and numeric characters with an underscore. This should assist with mapping the original input file name to the file name displayed in the logs.

For example, an input file name of “**u west alabama recs 07-Nov-2023.mrk**” results in the log displaying “I am 201269 (started from process id: 201253). I will be doing all of '/m1/voyager/2010.5.0/tmp/cgipost-**u_west_alabama_rec_07_Nov_2023_mrk**-201228.tmp' for you.”.

Create separate “Show Index” checkboxes for Staff and OPAC modules

Purpose of the Enhancement

The purpose of this enhancement is to allow separate settings for showing, or not showing, the index column in the staff and OPAC search results.

Description

The “Search – Index – Composite Definitions” and “Search -Indexes – Headings & Left-Anchored Definitions” settings in System Administration are enhanced to include “Show Index Col With Search Results - Staff” and “Show Index Col with Search Results - OPAC” options on the “Search Results” tab.

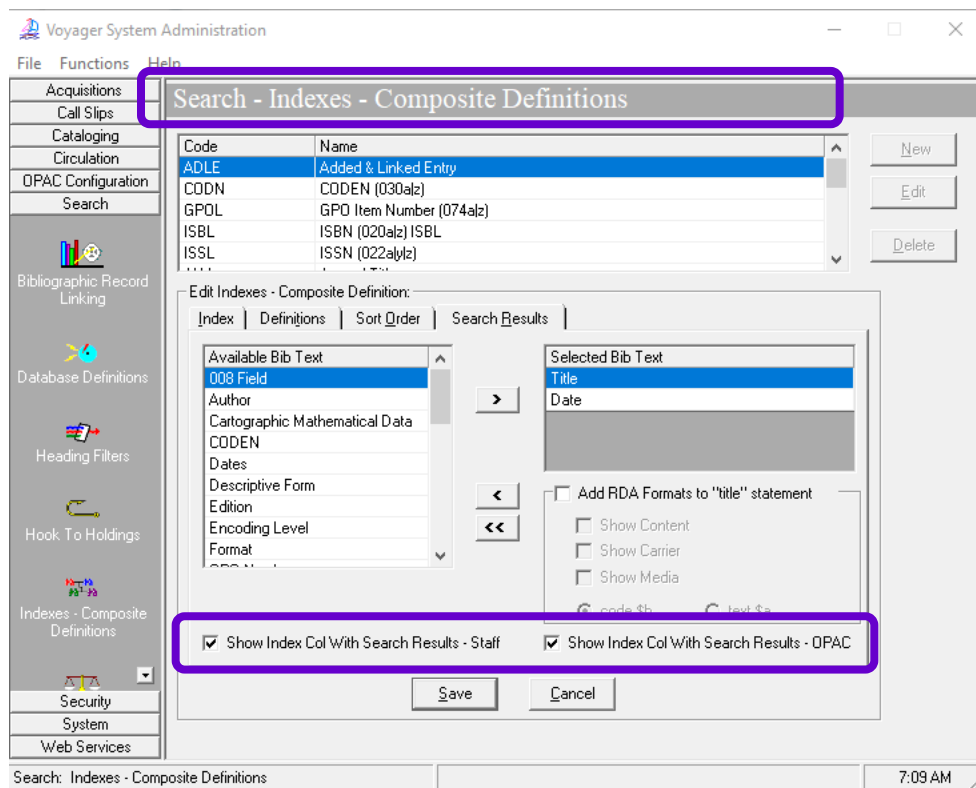
The value of the “Show Index Col With Search Results - Staff” controls whether the OPAC checkbox is enabled. The Staff checkbox must be turned on in order for the OPAC checkbox to be enabled.

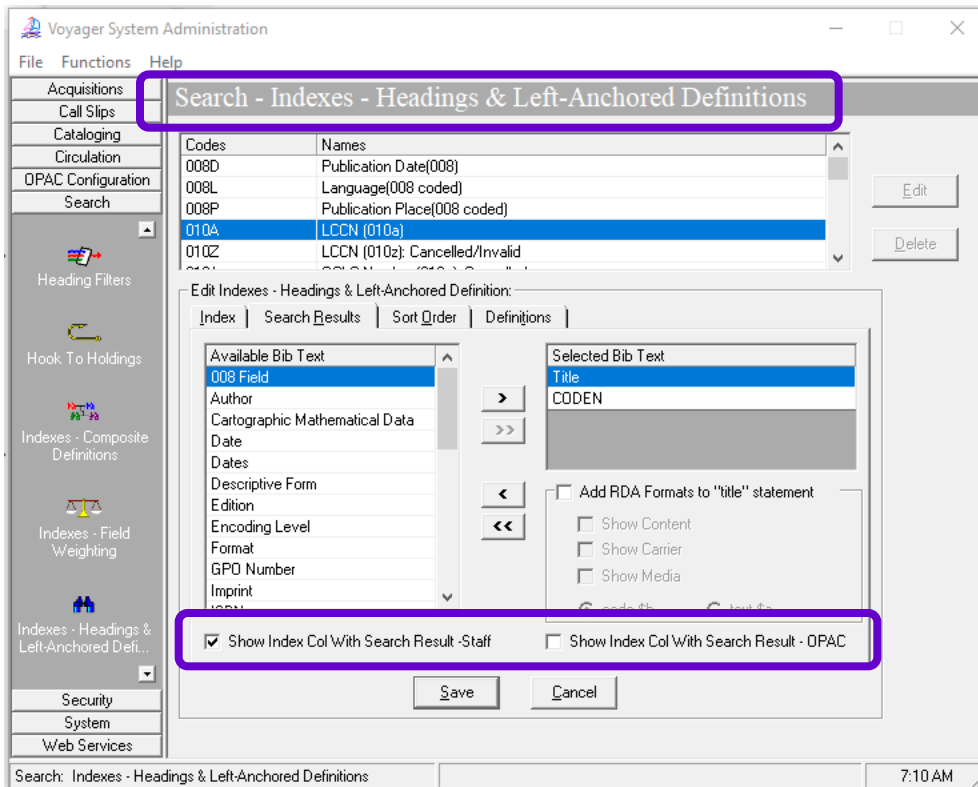
This provides for the following combinations:

- Off for both staff and OPAC
- On for staff, Off for OPAC
- On for Staff, On for OPAC

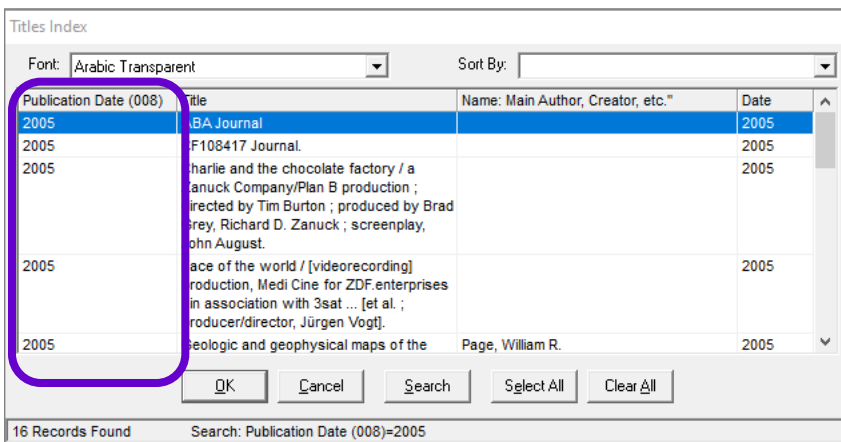
During the upgrade to 10.5, both Staff and OPAC options are set to match the value for “Show Index Column With Search Results” setting from your previous version of Voyager.

Only composite or bibliographic indexes permit setting these flags. For other search indexes, both Staff and OPAC are turned on by default and may not be changed.

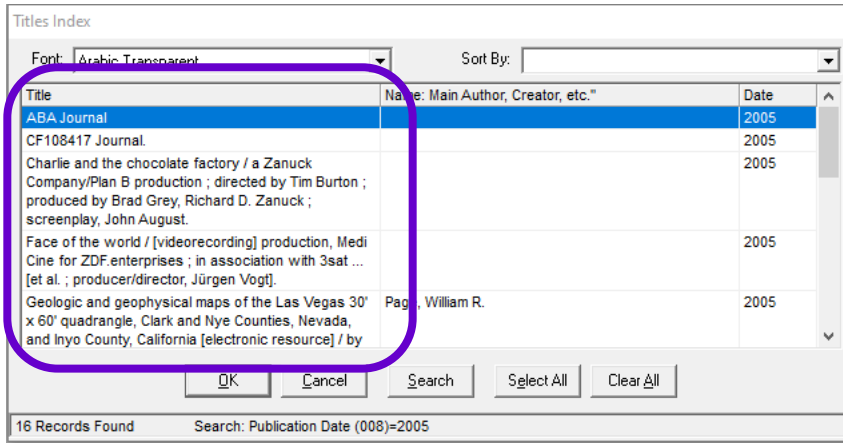




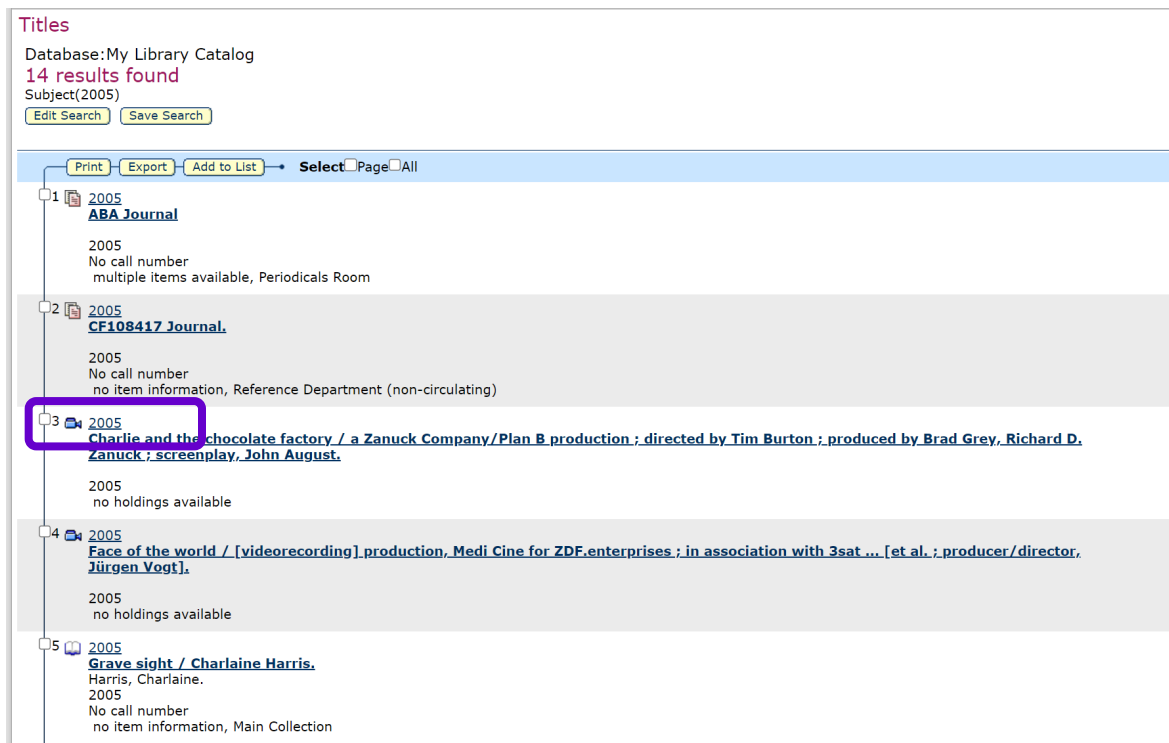
When the flag is turned on for Staff (checked), the index column will display as the first column in the search results in the staff modules.



When the flag is turned off for Staff (not checked), the index column will not display in the search results in the staff modules.








When the flag is turned on for OPAC (checked), the index will display as the first line for each hit in the search results in the OPAC.



When the flag is turned off for OPAC (not checked), the index will not display as the first line for each hit in the search results.

Oracle 19

Description

Oracle has been upgraded to Oracle 19c.

Oracle 12c Client and ODBC Drivers

Description

There is a known issue with unicode characters in Voyager Prepackaged Access reports using ODBC drivers newer than 10g. If unicode characters are an important part of your reports, it is suggested you do not upgrade your ODBC drivers.

Otherwise, new ODBC drivers are suggested for this version of Voyager. A new ODBC installation package has been created for the Oracle 12c client and ODBC drivers.

This new ODBC installation package now works with MS Access, 64-bit. MS Access, 32-bit is also still supported. You should install the ODBC drivers that are compatible with your version of Microsoft Office/MS Access (32-bit or 64-bit).

Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7 and 8

Description

Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7.4 or later (64-bit) is required for Voyager 10.5.

Red Hat 7 end of Maintenance Support is due June 30, 2024. Voyager continues to be supported on Red Hat 7 until that date. New Voyager installs should use Red Hat 8, and existing installs should plan to migrate to Red Hat 8 prior to Red Hat 7 end of Maintenance Support.

Windows 7 Support

Description

Windows 7 end-of-support was 14 January 2020. Best effort support for running Voyager clients on Windows 7 will continue after this date, but no new patches or hot fixes will be released to enable this platform. You are strongly encouraged to upgrade staff computers to Windows 10 as soon as possible.
