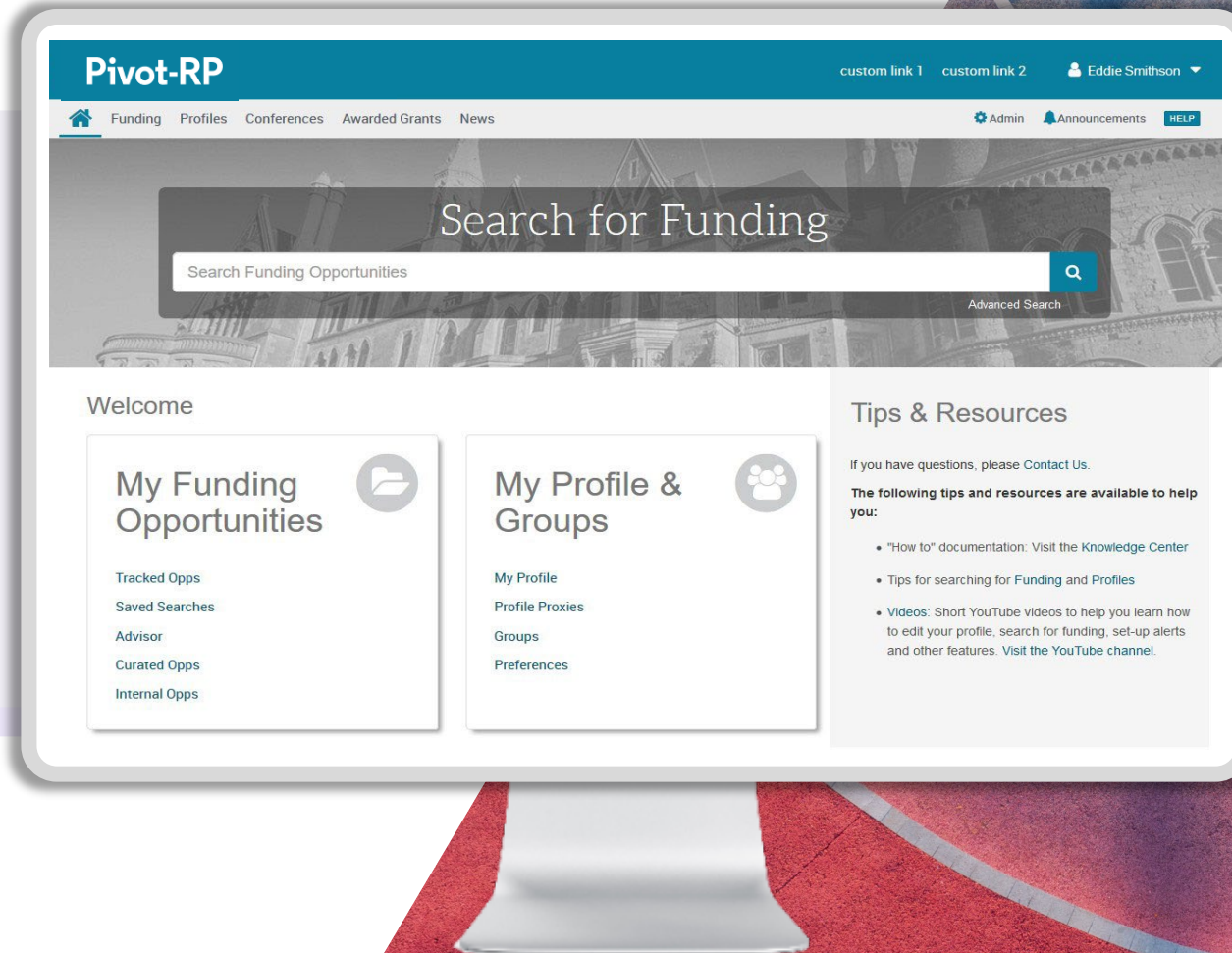

Key Benefits:

Easily identify prestigious prizes and awards to better promote them to your faculty and researchers. Leverage search, filtering, calendars and tracking features to manage prestigious awards and deadlines.

Administrators can now add internal/institutional contact information to the sidebar contact section of individual funding opportunities.

Use the 'Explode' option of the Advanced search keyword search to broaden result sets to include opportunities indexed with keywords 'above' the one selected in the keyword tree hierarchy (super-entities). Previously users could only narrow results.


New Prestigious Prizes and Awards Funding Type

Note: The list is not comprehensive, as there will be differences of opinion on the definition of 'prestigious'.



Important Notes: Prestigious Prizes and Awards Funding Type

- Prestigious Prizes, Honorifics and Awards labels in Pivot-RP are based on editorial coverage and curation of a variety of 'crowd sourced' lists of recognized prestigious awards - many of which were contributed by our customer community
- The list in Pivot-RP should not be considered comprehensive, as there will always be differences of opinion on the definition of 'prestigious' from institution to institution and region to region.
- It is also possible that a given funder or sponsor may have additional prestigious prizes listed on their websites than what is currently tracked in Pivot-RP. So, it may be worthwhile to visit the funder/sponsor's website directly to assess their offerings.
- Pivot-RP has on average over 7,000 total active prizes and awards. Approximately 1,000 prizes and awards are currently considered "Prestigious."
- As Pivot-RP focuses on displaying currently active and known recurring opportunities, not all identified prestigious opportunities will currently return in search results sets.
- We welcome feedback and suggestions to improve this feature. We will review and update the list of opportunities on at least a quarterly basis.

Pivot-RP Notes Overview

There are now multiple ways that Administrators can add local notes and information to the Pivot-RP funding opportunities that are seen by the users at your institution. These include:

- **Global Messages ("Research Office" Note)** - will display on all funding opportunities for your institution
- **Limited Submission Notes** - will display on all limited submission funding opportunities for your institution
- **Individual Opportunity Notes** - will display on individual funding opportunities
- **Funder Notes** - apply the same individual funding opportunity note to all individual opportunities from a given funder
- **Internal Contact Notes** - displays a note in the funder contact sidebar section of an individual opportunity
- **Internal Deadlines & Notes** - Admins can also add internal deadlines with accompanying deadline-specific notes

Keyword search including super-entities

Explode functionality in Keyword Search expanded: "Super-entities"

The Explode functionality in the keyword search has been improved to also enable searching for broad result sets that include all keywords 'up' the keyword tree, that is, 'above' the one selected.

The default setting for a keyword search is still to Include Sub-Entities.

For example, if you search for 'Artificial Intelligence or Cybernetics' and set it to 'Include Super-entities', then the result set will include all calls indexed with:

- Artificial Intelligence or Cybernetics
- Computer Science
- Natural and Physical Sciences, Mathematics and Technology

This broad result set would show all opportunities that someone looking for funding for a project within 'Artificial Intelligence' might be able to apply for, as an opportunity open to all Computer Sciences fields would likely also be open to funding projects more specifically related to AI.

For example, if you search for 'Psychology' and set it to 'Include Sub-entities', then the result set will include all calls indexed with the terms:

- Psychology
- Educational Psychology
- Behavior or Experimental Psychology
- Infant Psychology
- Etc.

By default, when searching by Keyword, Pivot-RP will apply the "Include Sub-entities" filter.

This will automatically include all terms 'below' the selected term in the keyword tree hierarchy.

Users can choose to include either, both or neither of the Sub-entities or Super-entities filters.
