ACQUISITIONS

- Central Negotiation:
 - Content (collection & portfolios) should be managed centrally on behalf of members
 - Institutions for which the content was negotiated for should be listed centrally
 - Negotiated cost per member should be managed centrally
 - License terms should be managed centrally
 - Activation of content should be done centrally on behalf of members
 - Acquisition order, fund, invoices should be managed by every individual member locally



Analytics Network

- When logging in to the Network Zone, reports can be created either for selected institutions or for the entire consortium
 - Reports for the entire consortium no institution selected
 - Reports for a specific institution select institution

Administration

 Support the ability to manage various configuration and administration elements for the entire network

- Current functionalities
 - Central Catalog Definitions
 - Normalization Rules
 - Cataloging Templates
 - Central Publishing
 - Group Settings



Administration

- Extend this to additional areas/functions
 - Shared Vendors allow creation of vendors in the Network zone and have them copied to all institutions
 - Support for configuration in acquisitions, fulfillment, resource sharing, etc... on Network Zone level
 - Log on to Alma as a super user representing the whole consortium and then having the possibility to switch between institutions




Administration

- Fulfillment Configuration Policies and TOUs
 - Allow definition of policies and terms of use and fulfillment units in the Network zone.
 - These entities will be seen by each institution as defined in the consortium level.
 - This will add another level to the hierarchy of the policies Library, Institution, Consortium, Generic(OTB)
