New and Changed Features

The following features are new or changed in this month's release of Leganto.

Add Items Directly to a Reading List

You can now add an item directly to a section (in addition to adding items from My Collection). A new + button was added to each section.

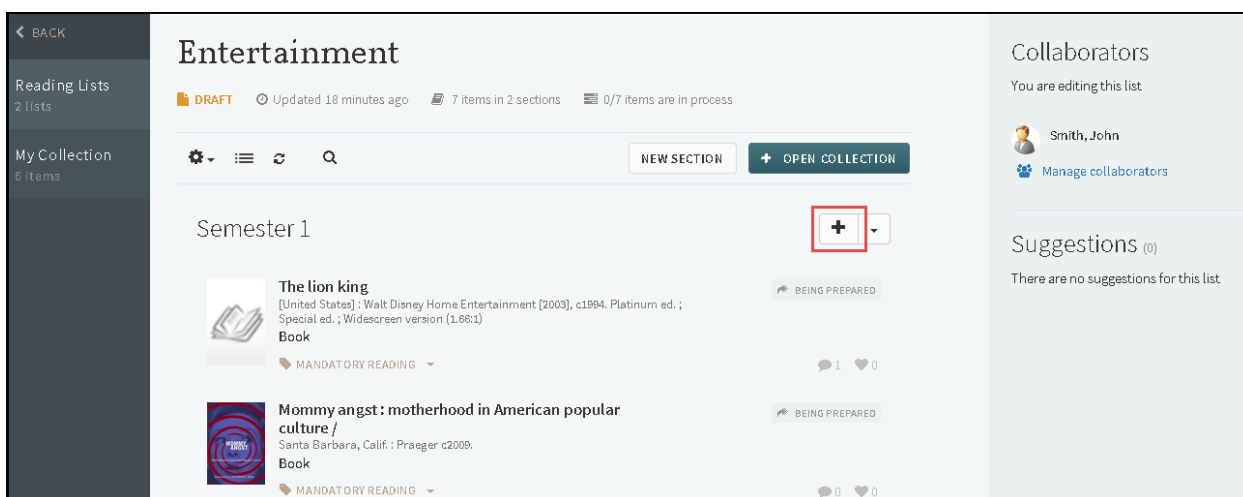


Figure 1: Reading List Page - Add Citation Button

This button opens the Search library dialog box.

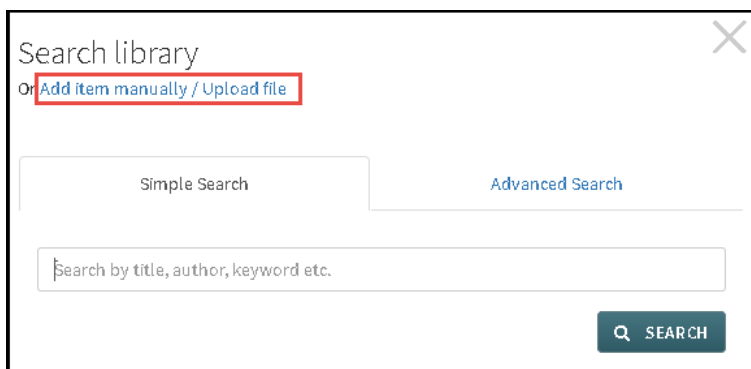



Figure 2: Add Citation dialog box – Search Library dialog

Welcome Wizard

Description

Leganto now presents a welcome wizard when you log in to Leganto.

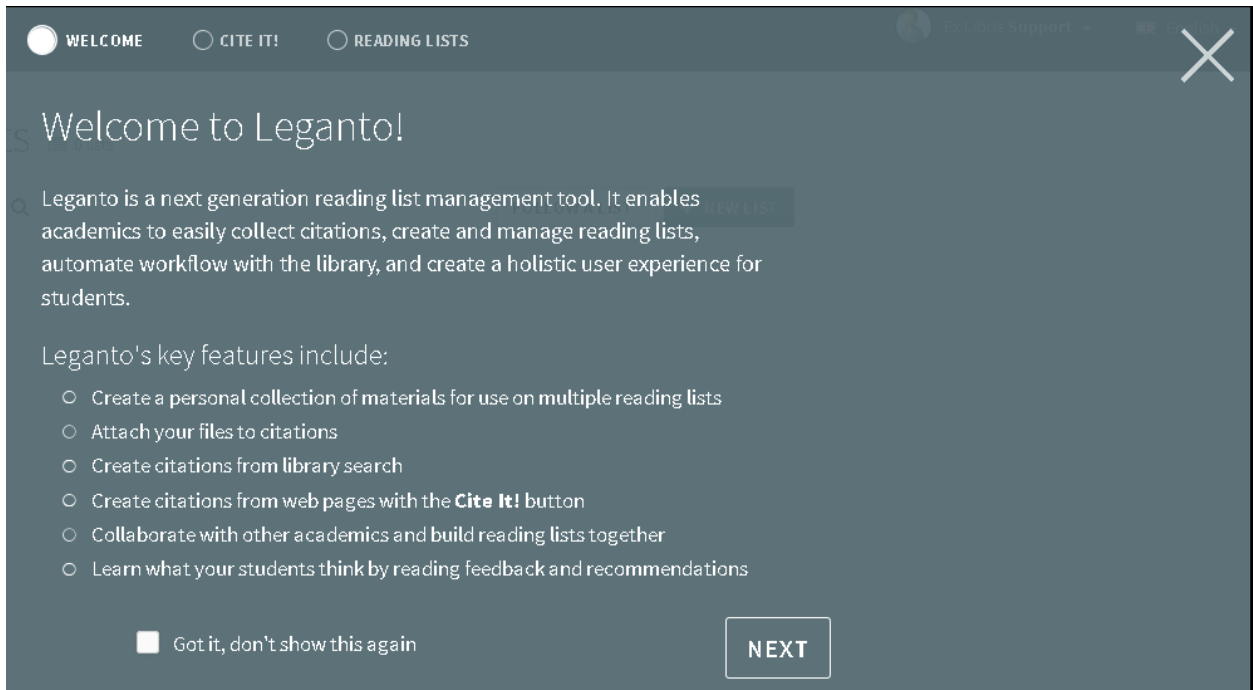


Figure 4: Welcome Wizard Page 1

The wizard is several pages long.

- You can view each page in the wizard using the tabs at the top of the page (**Welcome**, **Cite It!**, **Reading Lists**) or by clicking **Next** on each page.
- If you require more information, click **Click Here** on the last page of the wizard to open the *Leganto Product Description* [PDF].
- Close the wizard by clicking **X** at the top of any page of the wizard, or by clicking **Finish** on the last page.
- If you don't want to see the wizard the next time you enter Leganto, select **Got it, don't show this again** on any page before dismissing the wizard.
- To view the wizard at any time, select **Help** in the user menu at the top of the page.

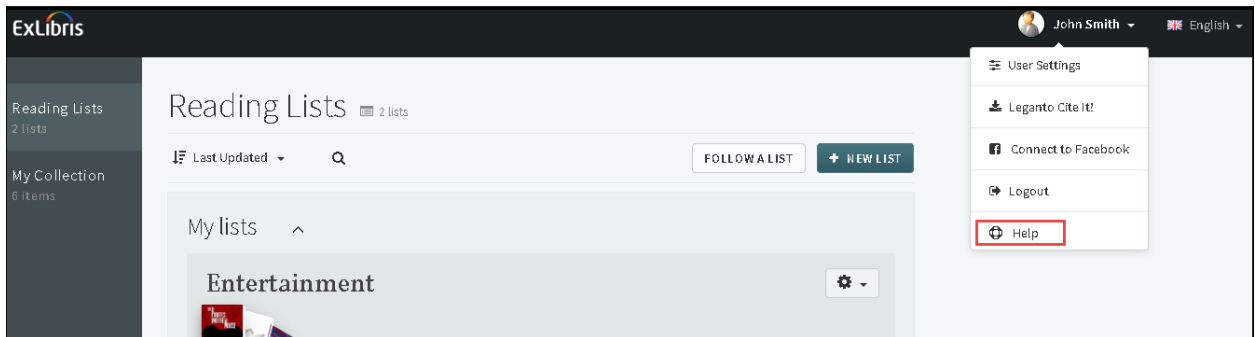


Figure 5: User Menu

Hide/Show Reading List Student Discussions

Description

Leganto now enables an instructor to hide all student discussion threads for a reading list.

The student discussion thread appear on each citation page, and enables students to add and respond to comments about the citation.

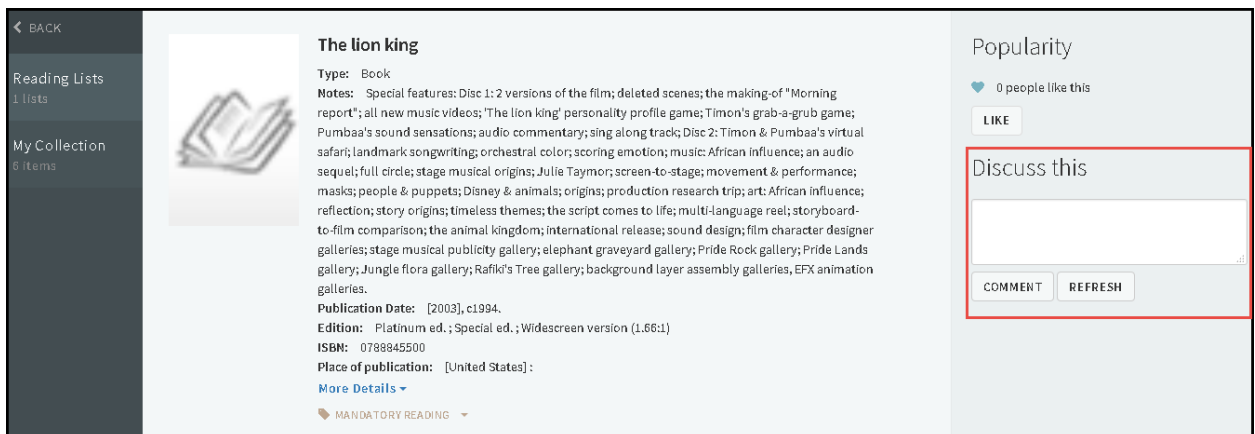


Figure 6: Citation Page - Student Discussion Thread

A new menu option **Hide Student Discussion Thread** is available in the Reading List main menu.

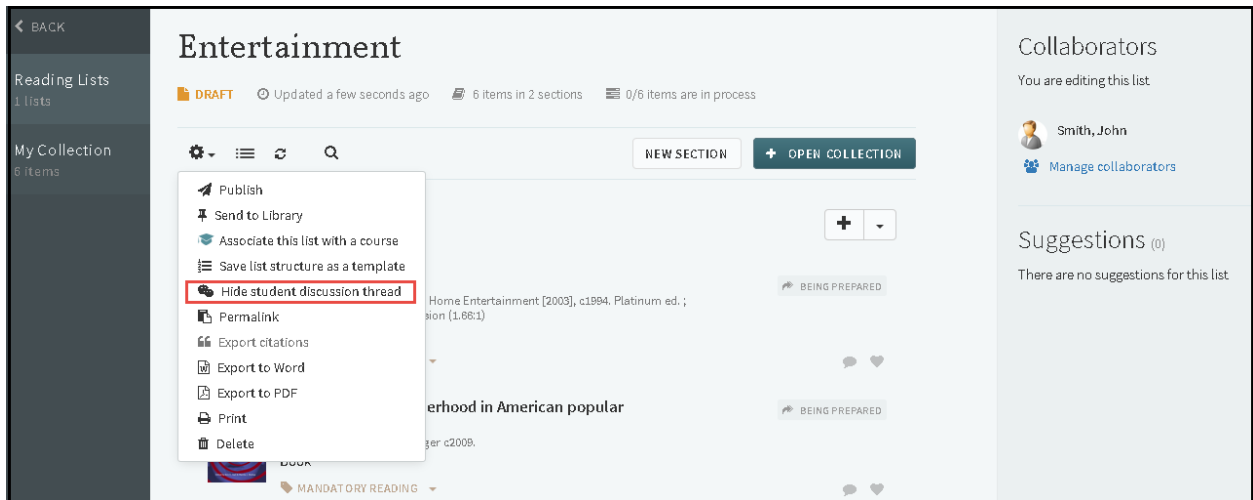


Figure 7: Reading List Main Menu

Select this option to hide (and turn off) all discussions for all citations in this list.

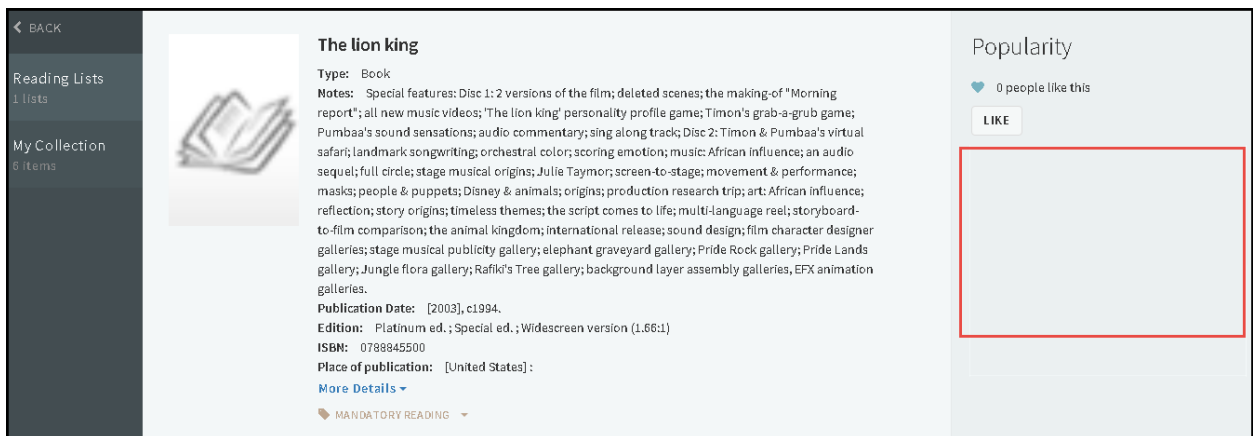


Figure 8: Citation Page - No Student Discussion

Select **Show Student Discussion Thread** in the Reading List main menu to restore the discussions. Comments that previously existed in the threads are also restored.

Copying Sections

Description

You can now copy sections, either to the same or a different reading list.

To copy a section:

- 1 Select **Copy Section** from the Section main menu.

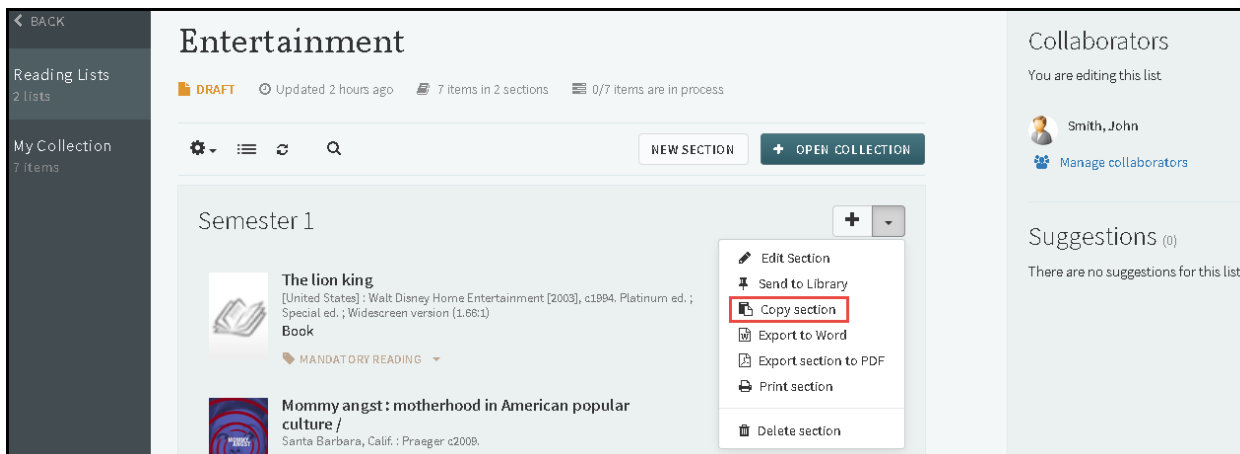


Figure 9: Section Main Menu

The Copy Section dialog box appears.

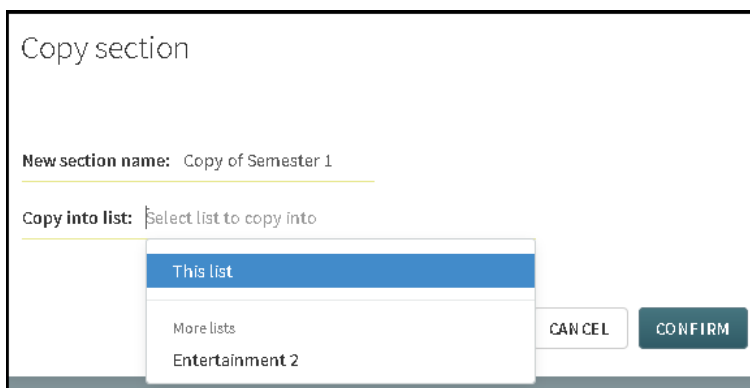


Figure 10: Copy Section Dialog Box

- 2 Select the reading list into which to copy the section, or **This List** to copy the section to the reading list you are currently editing.
- 3 Click **Confirm**. The new list's name is Copy of <Old List's Name>.

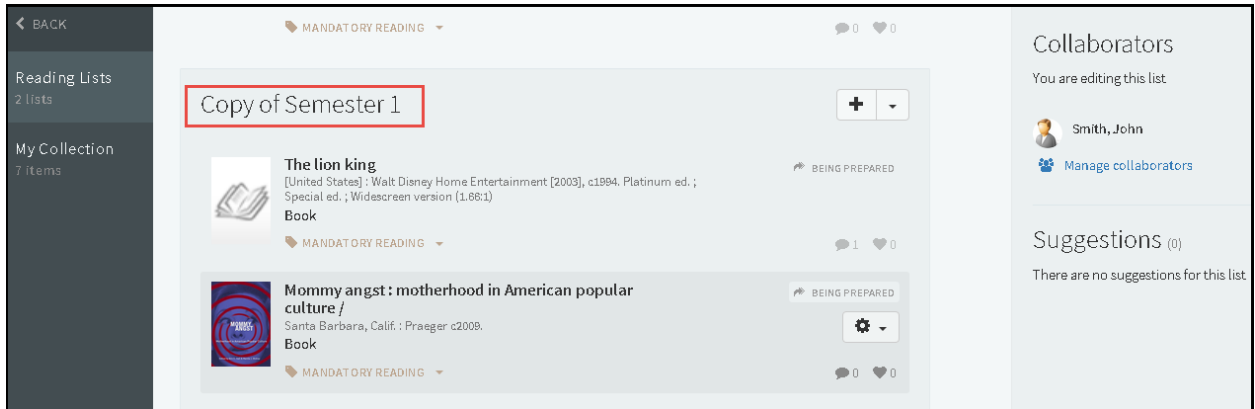


Figure 11: Reading List with Duplicated Section

Note: Note that there can be two sections with the same name in a reading list, so if you copy the same section again to the same reading list, it will have the same name.

Other Changes

The following additional (minor) changes were made for this release:

- The citation type now appears in each citation on the reading list page.

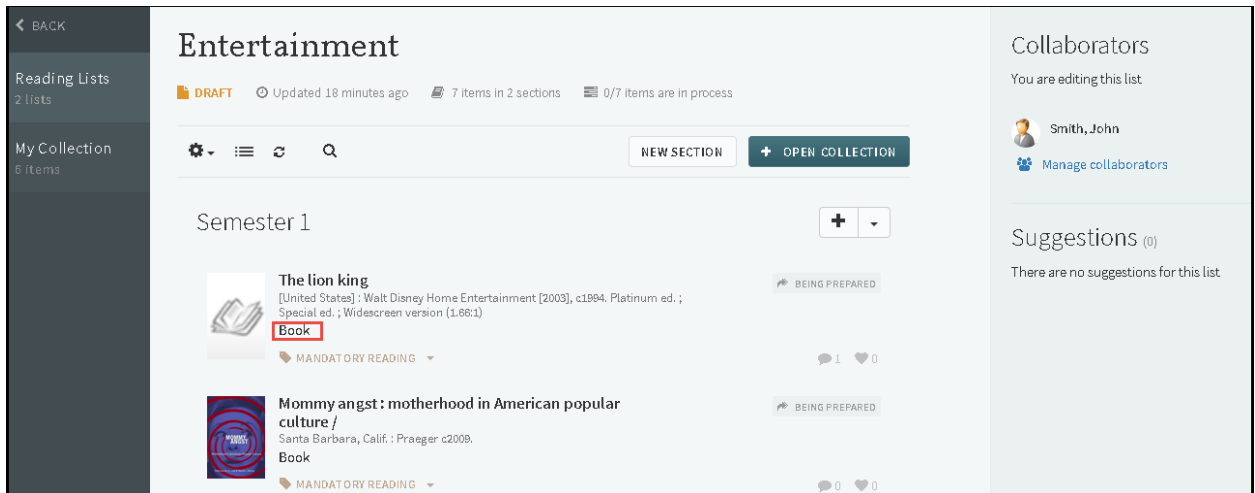


Figure 12: Reading List Page

- You can now minimize sections in a reading list. Click the section name to minimize (or restore) the section.

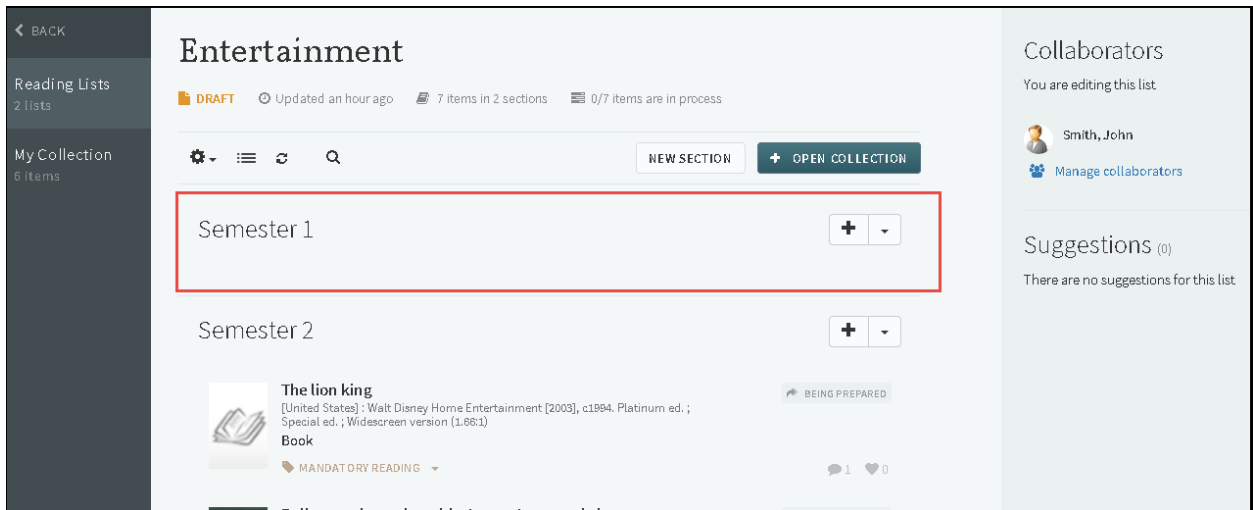


Figure 13: Reading List Page with Minimized Section

- You can now export a reading list or a section to Microsoft Word format. Select **Export to Word** from the Reading List or Section main menu.

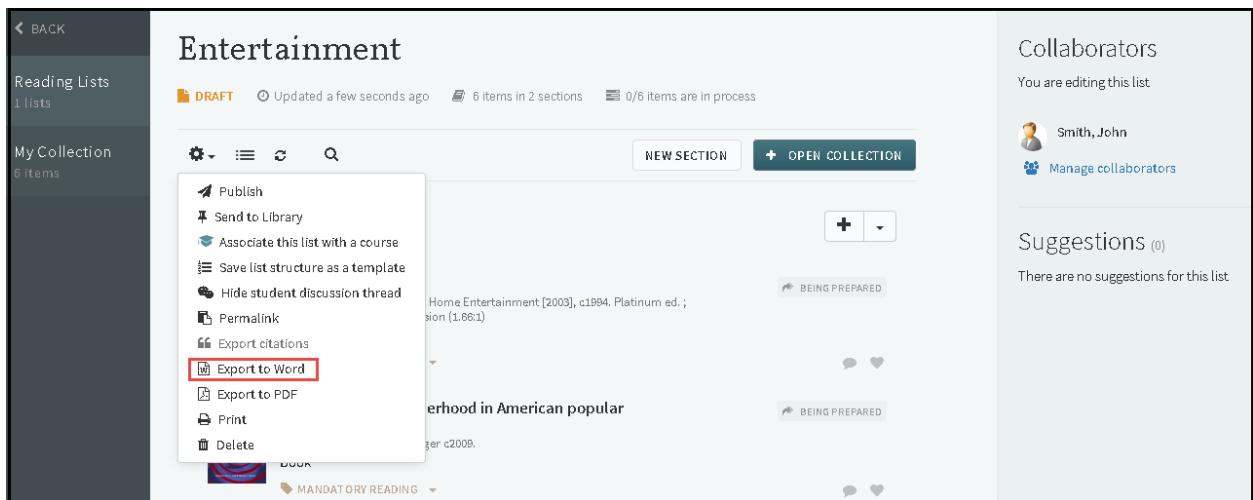


Figure 14: Reading List Main Menu - Export to Word

When opened in Microsoft Word, an exported reading list appears as follows (an exported section appears similarly, without the reading list title):

- Leganto now provides animated tooltips to suggest certain actions, for example:
 - When a reading list is empty, a tooltip suggests that you add a section.

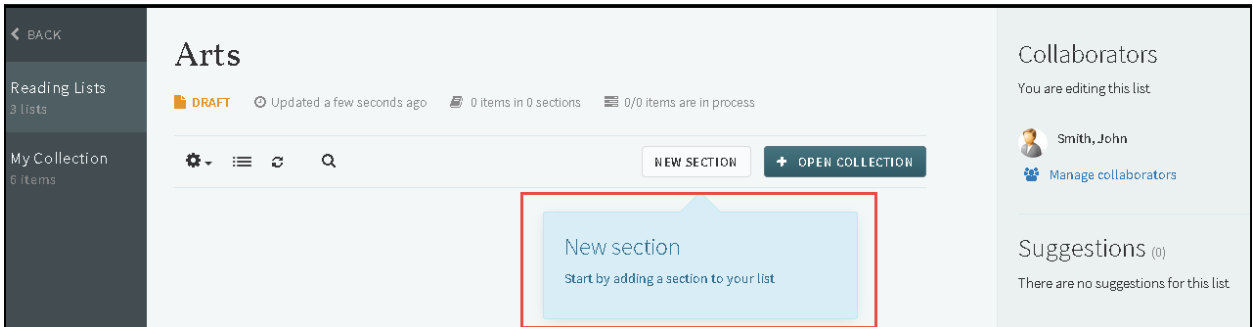


Figure 16: Reading List - No Sections

- When a section is empty, a tooltip suggests that you add an item.

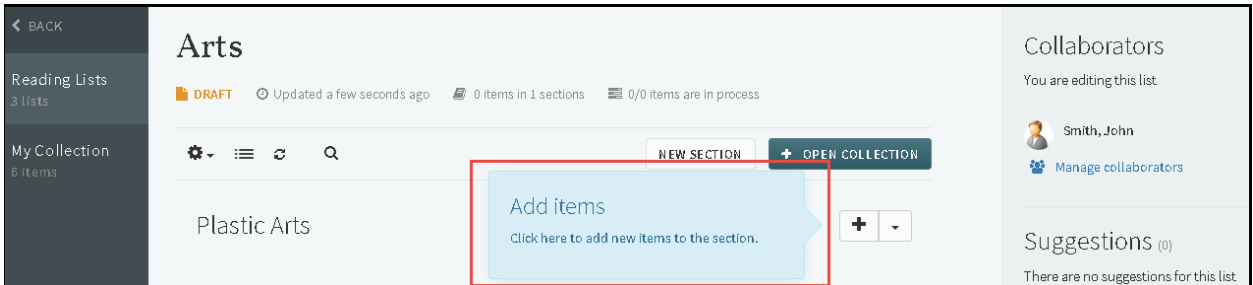


Figure 17: Reading List Section - No Items

- The permalink for a reading list directed you to the log in page if you were not logged in; after logging in, the main page appeared. This was fixed, and now the reading list appears after logging in in this case.
