

1 Translating Alephino into a new language

Alephino supports multiple languages simultaneously. Its GUI modules as well as the Web components can be switched between various communication languages while operated. If your language is not covered by the current Alephino release out-of-the-box, you can easily create your own Alephino language pack. This applies to all languages that make use of characters based on latin.

To ensure that all necessary information will be supplied in the new language make a copy of an existing folder or file and name it after the abbreviation of the new language you choose. Pls. find below a list of all files and folders that are in need for language specific derivates. Language packs shipped with Alephino releases may be incomplete or not properly translated. If you encounter faulty or missing translations we are grateful for any improvement, so pls. inform us.

The english and the german version of Alephino – that's the files and folders with naming "eng" and "ger" - are maintained by Ex Libris Germany and hence can be trusted to be complete. We recommend to always take the set of "eng" - files and folders for pattern.

Please note that only plain texts are to be translated, **codes, tags and placeholders** must not be touched!

Examples for various file formats that occur in Alephino

ALL = All fields

0142 = Subfield **&1** not permitted !

0101 = Link from **%s** to **%s** not possible

&f-base - Pending hold requests

All files located in sublist **etc** of the Alephino server environment are encoded in ISO Latin-1 (Western character set) while internally the Alephino works with Unicode. All external files are translated dynamically into Unicode in the process of reading in by Alephino programs. With that simple plain text editor programs that are available on all supported platforms can be used for the processing of Alephino control files rather than Unicode-capable tools. If you need special national special characters, feel free to use another ISO Latin (ISO 8859) character encoding. To ensure proper translation into Unicode and hence correct display of special characters, a so called translate table must then be applied to the Alephino Server as well as the Alephino Web OPAC configuration files *etc/alephino.cfg* and *etc/alipac.cfg*:

4 Implementing the translated files

4.1 Server and Web Services

For the **Server and Web Service Module** edit the file `..../etc/alephino.cfg` :

To set your new language as default :

4.2 Web OPAC

For the **Web OPAC** edit the file `..../etc/alipac.cfg` :

a) Section(s) (SortLNG):

4.3 Server and Web Services

For the **Z39.50-Gateway** edit the file `..etc/zgate.cfg`:

4.3 GUI select boxes

For language selection box in the GUI client change file ..\etc\marctable.ext:

4.4 GUI preferred interface language

To make your language the one the GUI comes up with on start, process file ..\Alephcom\tab\conv_lng.dat

```
LNG L Your Language ← add line
GER L Deutsch
ENG L English
```

Set your new language as a default by placing it in on top.

4.5 Language selection in Web OPAC

Add interface language: ../htdoc/alipac_<lng>/option-display-form.htm

The gif file with the iconized flag symbolizing the new language must be placed in
/htdoc/alipac_<lng>/icon/.

You may as well decide to replace one of the preconfigured languages by yours.

4.6 Language selection in Web Services

After having logged on to the Web services you can choose the language. To have yours added, process files/htdoc/aliadm_<lng>/Logged.htm

You may as well decide to replace one of the preconfigured languages by yours.

4.7 Language selection in Z39.50 Gateway Administration

For the Z39.50 Administration the same applies as already outlined for the Alephino Web service module. After having logged on you can switch the language. To have yours added, process files `../htdoc/aliadm_<lng>/ZLogged.htm`

You may as well decide to replace the preconfigured language by yours.

The relevant section of the file `../htdoc/aliadm_<lng>/ZLogged.htm` would then look like this:

4.8 Add language to web server configuration

Don't forget to configure the (Apache) Web Server. For the administrative sites of your new language the following entry in file `vhost.alephino` is necessary:

# Web Administration
Alias /german "C:/Program files (x86)/ExLibris/MarcServ_50/htdoc/aliadm_ger"
Alias /english "C:/Program files (x86)/ExLibris/MarcServ_50/htdoc/aliadm_eng"
Alias /language "C:/Program files (x86)/ExLibris/MarcServ_50/htdoc/aliadm_lng"
```

← add the above line

In order to make the change effective pls. restart the Apache server.
