Like the blind prophet, Tiresias in the Greek tragedies, he has seen all and knows the tragic destination of our strivings—all result in loneliness and death. Painted in Barcelona, the distorted style is reminiscent of the drama found in Spanish religious painting, particularly that of El Greco. The melancholy and pathos of Picasso's works from his Blue period reflect his sadness at the suicide of his young friend, Casagemas.

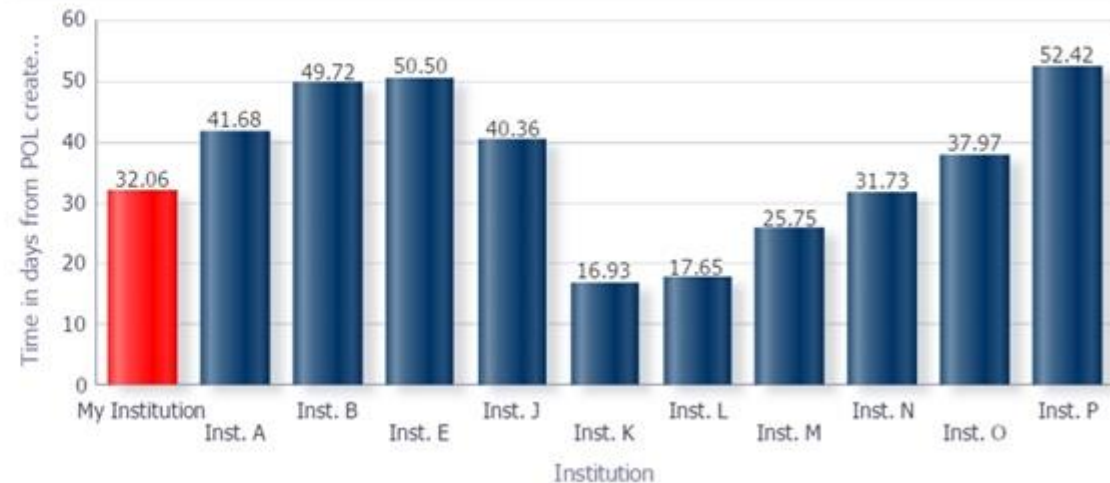

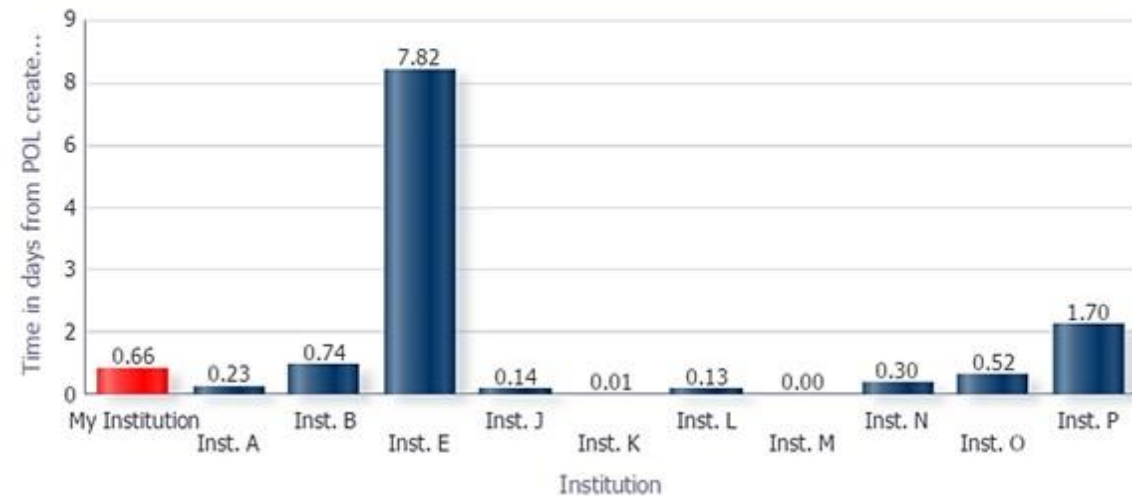
