

How to add a message using the sign-in alert bar in Primo and Primo VE

Introduction

- There may be a case where the institution wants to notify all users of a certain message.
- There are several ways to do this, one of which is to change the message in the sign-in alert bar, to cover cases where patrons enter your discovery not via the initial page.
- In this case we will replace the sign-in message label (no need in customization) to include also “We continue to monitor the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and its global impact. See Trust Center for more details.” with links
